He often went into rural areas with the Mobile Medical Team to faithfully help local people improve their standard of living by removing jiggers, disinfecting their homes, and talking about basic hygiene.

He leaves behind a wife, Agnes, and five children. He will always be remembered and missed immensely.

After the burial, the IFF Uganda working board held a meeting and Paul Isabirye was proposed to succeed Robert. IRFF UK as primary funder also approved this move!

Robert Mwogeza will always be remembered for the enormous effort he put into his activities to help the communities of Uganda.
