### **Religious leaders speak out** by John O'Neill

How very encouraging and uplifting to see the major religious leaders speaking out recently about key moral issues such as abortion and marriage. The Archbishop of Canterbury Dr. Rowan Williams also criticised the pressures of modern life eroding the time and space children need to develop. He warned that adults who refused to grow up could become 'abusers' of children by default. He condemned a tax system and benefit system that favours mothers who go back to work over those who stay at home to bring up their children. He also warns of a society in which childhood is 'consumerised' and 'sexualised'.

Research has established the fact that once out of denial and trying to justify the abortion, innumerable post abortive women will suffer guilt, remorse, grief, anxiety and eating disorders, suicides, depression, low self-esteem, difficult relationships, despair, anger, inability to forgive oneself etc. Furthermore, many women get infections, after having an abortion, which can lead to infertility and breast cancer. There are twenty-eight worldwide studies linking breast cancer to induced abortion. A recent letter published in the Daily Mail spoke about a lady who was a successful secretary before having an abortion. After the abortion the lady became very introverted and disturbed. She has since been in and out of mental hospitals and has been sectioned several times. The letter (written by her sister) mentioned how sad it was that there was no adviser around at the time to suggest adoption, and how this is still the case today, and also, how many lives is abortion ruining, the cost of which is hidden within the NHS budget and never discussed. A very poignant letter indeed. Abortion on demand should

be stopped completely. This grotesque system has murdered six million babies since 1967.

The Blair government has been undermining the legal props of marriage and boosting the economic and social status of single parents and cohabiting couples. Even it has been promised to remove the word marriage from all state documents as it discriminates against homosexuals! There is a realisation among police chiefs and academics that crime and educational and economic failure have their roots in disrupted families and single parenthood. Cardinal Murphy-O'Connor asked that people should question candidates in the recent election about issues such as abortion and marriage. Excellent advice, as all the evidence shows that the traditional family is the best for rearing children and creating stability in society.

Recent articles in various newspapers have commented on some shocking sexual matters: "A generation of pupils pressured into having sex." "One in five girls now admits to having had sex with three partners by the age of 14." "Warning for doctors after 10-year-old girls are put on the pill."

In a recent publication issued by Mediamarch it states: "Pornography is now mainstream...under the new regulator Ofcom, we no longer have guidelines on taste and decency. In future TV programmes will be judged on harm and offence and on 'generally accepted standards' using a 'light touch'.

The sexual revolution and the permissive society has had devastating consequences for our society in general, and particularly for the countless adults and children caught in the rocketing rates of increases in divorces, teenage pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases. The 'safe sex' education programmes in many schools only encourage the children to have sex. Such programmes are a complete disaster and are a form of child abuse.

Religious people are supposed to be the conscience of the nation, and to be "salt" and "light" in the society as stated in the Bible. The moral and spiritual laws are there for a purpose: to enable people to understand how to live their lives successfully, and how to make an ideal world. Those laws have stood the test of time and we ignore them at our peril! Historical studies by

various historians show that: "no society in history has been able to survive for long without a strong moral code," and, "that immorality corrupts individuals and destroy societies!" Moral and spiritual values have been in constant decline in Britain since the nineteen fifties. The results are: a ten-fold increase in crimes and enormous increases in social problems. We reap as we sow!

Recently a woman aged 28 committed suicide because she found out that she was infertile. She had caught chlamydia which can stay latent for years. She had recently married. Thousands of young girls also will become infertile through catching chlamydia. Sexually transmitted diseases amongst young people are at epidemic levels. 35% of these diseases are incurable!

The media and various other outlets are having a devastating effect upon our society with ever increasing levels of sex, violence and bad language.

Religious people in particular should feel responsible to challenge the prevalence of unacceptable standards in the media etc. Our responsibility is to tell people the truth. If they do not listen they will face judgment for sure. Many media people are deceived into thinking that it is normal to be promiscuous.

Writing letters can definitely pay off. All the evidence (surveys, statistics etc) is on the side of righteous thinking people. There are a number of examples of media people apologising and expressing gratitude for being made aware of the importance of society adhering to a moral code. A letter written with sincerity, conviction, and from a principled point of view, backed up with clear evidence can definitely help to change people's thinking.

There are a number of people living in towns and cities in Britain who never hesitate to act whenever there is a moral issue in their area or nationally. There are various moral groups who do excellent work in defending moral and family values. They all need more support. Joining a moral group is another very important way of fighting back against unacceptable media standards. Organising petitions, speaking on local and national radio stations has shown to be a very effective way of obtaining results.

Our young people are in desperate need of proper guidance and true values in society. An end to S.T.D.'s and the "job culture" can only come about

through proper moral values being integrated throughout society.

Let us all follow the example of our religious leaders (please write to them and thank them. I did that and I received very positive replies!) and not hesitate to defend moral values in our areas – especially for the sake of our young people – many of whom find their lives in turmoil because of the promiscuous standards prevalent in society.

### **Movement for Marriage**

I recently attended a meeting in central London organised by the "Movement for Marriage." The vision statement read, "The Movement for Marriage is an alliance of those who seek, within their spheres of influence, to promote marriage, the lifelong faithful union of one man and one woman, in the life of our nation. It seeks, by appropriate means, to make known the proven benefits of marriage and to encourage respect for it. It is committed to stand against those influences, which damage, or could even lead to the destruction of marriage. Furthermore, it seeks to promote the use of the established words- 'marriage,' 'husband,' 'wife' and 'spouse' on every appropriate occasion." There were key people attending the meeting from various organisations directly, or indirectly involved with the subject of marriage. There were a number of speakers and round table discussions. What was truly shocking was the clear evidence provided of the effects caused to countless adults and children, and society in general by the decline of marriage. I was very moved by the determination and sincerity expressed about the absolute need for the government to reverse its anti-marriage stance. We heard how the civil service is politicised against marriage, and how various minority lobby groups are influencing the government against traditional marriage. It was stated that more people from ethnic minority backgrounds needed to be involved with this very noble initiative. Links have already been established with pro-marriage M.P.'s, and meetings have been held in rooms in the houses of parliament. It was very inspiring to see people taking such a strong stand in defence of marriage and family values. The main organisers of the meeting were, Dennis Wrigley from the Maranatha moral group, and Reverend Edward Pratt, Executive Trustee from Marriage Resource. **The Washington AIDS International Teens  
(WAIT)**

In response to the terrible plague of AIDS, a number of young people have decided to take action. Beginning in Washington, D.C., teens have joined in a radical approach to fighting AIDS, by using performing arts to convey the message. The Washington AIDS International Teens (WAIT) use hip hop, break dancing, rap, singing, martial arts and acting to teach young people how HIV is spread, how it attacks the immune system, why getting tested is important, and the best way to protect yourself and those you love – by choosing to save sex for one lifetime relationship that is faithful.

The all-volunteer WAIT team performs at schools, health fairs, churches and public events. In the past two and a half years, they have done more than 400 performances, and have trained new teams in eight states. A project of the Washington AIDS International Foundation (WAIF), which was initiated by Dr. Chang Shik Yang, WAIT has rapidly become the most active AIDS prevention outreach in Washington D.C., and has worked closely with many other health education organizations, such as the American Red Cross, Young Men's Christian Association (YMCA), the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and other national and international groups.

WAIT has received a uniformly high rating by faculty, students, ministers, and health care workers for the interest and effectiveness of the presentation. Many youth in the audiences expressed a decision to embrace an abstinent lifestyle as a result of the program. (about 60-70%!!) Several have also been inspired to pursue careers in HIV/AIDS care or research. More than 500 young people are signed up for future training with the WAIT team.

While it is deliberately independent and unconnected to any faith-based group or organization, WAIT serves many faith organizations, including churches, synagogues and mosques. We teach that, scientifically, HIV can only be successfully stopped by every individual choosing abstinence and faithful lifetime partnerships, that is, marriage. We also teach that each person should develop and use their talents

to convey this message to others. Also, because we use youth culture, kids all over the world can relate to it. So we are able to serve any nation and faith, as a humanitarian health-educational organisation, in a way which empowers their traditions and families, but which is exciting and "cool" for their youth.

The Concept of WAIT:

Dr. Yang founded the Washington AIDS International Foundation in September 2001. In March, he brought me on to be co-director. My family had just concluded a project organising a talent showcase of abstinent kids from twenty-one schools, churches and youth groups; I had reported the huge success of using performing arts to convey the abstinence message. We agreed at the time of my coming on that I would organise a teen performing arts group to teach HIV/AIDS prevention, so from day one, WAIT was in the picture, although only in the embryonic stage at that moment. Dr. Yang had received my name to lead WAIF in prayer, and I had been praying since September 11 to have a chance to teach kids, parents and teachers abstinence and successful life choices, so we both knew that God had brought this together, and we have been united on every point since that initial covenant we made before God and each other.

WAIT is largely self-supporting. Funds are spent on necessities only, and for the actual activities – food, gas, transportation and performing equipment are the major expenses.

Internally, WAIT has three levels of attainment. To join, a candidate must be living an abstinent lifestyle and be committed to helping others. On the first level of membership, the teens learn the facts about HIV and AIDS, perform in the skit and game show, and develop their skills and talents, as well as do fundraising. The second level involves taking personal responsibility for expanding the message: creating a website, starting an abstinence club, developing some new literature, etc. The third level involves having total ownership and ability to train others.

Teens having reached the second level are eligible for interstate travel, and those on the third level are able to travel with the team to other countries. WAIT involves living the message, both of saving sex for lifetime marriage and fidelity within, for the sake of lasting happiness and of developing one's own dreams and talents as the path to helping others. Teens who are involved

have developed existing skills to a very high level, through performing in so many venues, but they also have learned that these gifts find their highest expression when used for others.

In one exiting project, WAIT has developed an exchange project with a similar group in Jerusalem. The Multicultural Dance Troup of the Municipality of Jerusalem hosted WAIT for a two week visit, and WAIT will host them this July in Washington, D.C.

This initiative tested a new approach to youth problems common to both Israel and the U.S.A., including ethnic and religious conflict, unequal educational access, and AIDS prevention, through a combination of international cultural exchange, performing arts, and community service.

With youth from Jewish, Muslim, Christian and all ethnicities joining together, and with the support of Service For Peace volunteers, creating positive activities to combat violence and AIDS, this is a model of youth putting ideals into action.

Last summer, a similar partnership took place at the International religious and International Peace Sports Festival (IPSF), where WAIT performed, educated and trained others from 53 countries.

WAIT has come to Britain!

The Washington AIDS International Teens (WAIT) team will be visiting Britain this September. In Britain, they would like to visit schools, churches, community centres and other places and teach the facts and encourage young people to focus on their talents and dreams rather than make risky choices that could lead to despair!

A WAIT team has been set up in Britain, headed by Nicole Schnapp, to prepare for their coming. The key areas of Outreach, Materials, Performances and Finance have been identified, with responsible people asked to lead. Already, three planning meetings have been held.

The ultimate goals of WAIT are to:

Change "free sex culture" into – a "God centred culture!" -

Change relationships into - true relationships!

Go beyond the prevalent condom culture of today.

They want to show that being abstinent is not being a "loser", but a "winner"! and being abstinent is a POSITIVE lifestyle!

## TRUE FAMILY VALUES

*(The following excerpts are compiled by Frank van der Stok and taken from the book "True Family Values" which can be purchased; details, address, etc. on the last page)*

### 1. Introduction:

#### What are True Family Values?

What exactly are Family values? According to Webster's Dictionary, a value is Something, as a principle or quality, intrinsically valuable or desirable. The common expression, family values, then, would mean those principles or qualities associated with the family which are intrinsically valuable or desirable.

The obvious family value, then, would be love. Others might include care, acceptance, intimacy, commitment, shared responsibility, and so forth. To call these family values would be to say that all people find love, care, acceptance and so forth intrinsically valuable or desirable. And of course, all people do desire these things; this is what makes us human. And everyone seems to affirm that something called family values will help our society. Thus everyone from Catholic bishops to homosexual activists endorse something called family values.

However, we will use the term, true family values. We do this because there is something missing from the consideration of values alone. What is missing is a sense of good and evil, of what is healthy and what is unhealthy, or of what leads to prosperity and what leads to misery. The term is so general that it is meaningless.

For instance, we can be sure that both saints and murderers desire care and acceptance. Both virgins and adulterers surely desire love and commitment. Espousing family values alone has no relationship with what people actually do. The cry for family values does nothing to improve the safety of the streets or the sanctity of society. It does not even answer the question, What is a family? This is why we must examine the question of true family values.

To accomplish this, we are developing the notion of values beyond simple reverence of love, care and acceptance. We believe that to have meaning, our values must define both norms and goals. Our values should enlighten us as to the behaviours or actions which lead to the accomplishment of those norms and goals. Therefore we need more than values; we need principles for the growth of love, through which we can achieve our shared goals, such as freedom, peace, unification and happiness.

We put forth the following seven principles, which we believe bring about the growth of love:

1. Make a commitment to your family and hometown.
2. Live for the greater whole.
3. Learn true love in the school of the family.
4. Dedicate your own family to the global family of humankind.
5. Strive daily to put the spiritual above the physical.
6. Align with heaven to share blessings on earth.
7. Be sexually pure to create the true culture.

These principles clarify the essence of family values. Their study reveals why the family is a subject of universal interest, is so controversial, and is of crucial importance to the future of our world. More than that, these principles are stepping stones for our families and communities to achieve that which we most value: the growth of love.

#### The Consequences of Family Breakdown

A. Why does family breakdown have such devastating consequences? It is because the family is the foundation of civilization.

1. The family is the most important school for our lives.

a) The family is the school of love and school of peace. Our first challenge is to cherish our children and strengthen our family. Families are the foundation of life. If we have stronger families, we will have a stronger nation.

b) The experiences which shape our fundamental character take place in the family from the moment of birth.

c) The place where we have our first experiences of human behaviour:

Children learn filial piety as induced by the genuine care of their parents for them, and

seeing the behaviour of their elder siblings toward their parents.

Children learn harmonious relations between brothers and sisters by the example of the harmonious love between their father and mother.

Children learn parental heart by taking care of their younger siblings.

If they don't see these things, they grow up with scars.

d) The place in which people and things are valued:

Children learn their own value through the love they receive.

Children learn the value of other persons by the way others express love to each other.

Children learn the value of things through how others treat things in the household.

2. The first school of ethics and morality.

a) The school of manners and deportment.

Parents naturally and irrepressibly try to instill moral norms in their children.

No parent wants their child to be violent, rude or selfish. Parents are proud when their children respect others and earn the respect of others.

b) Family characteristics are handed down.

Many clans excel because of the family tradition of education or public service.

Bad characteristics and habits, such as smoking, alcoholism and mental illness, also run in families.

3. The basic structure of human existence.

a) Animals form families only to multiply. The bond of kinship is temporary and biologically-based.

b) Human kinship bonds are permanent elements of our lives.

c) The family is the first institution of human life.

d) The family is the universal institution for human existence.

e) Therefore the family is not created by culture. It is the creator of culture. It is a primary expression of our common human nature. Therefore it is the basis for common values and understanding among people the world over.

4. The family is the model and microcosm of society.

a) Society is composed of citizens expressing the quality of love learned in their families.

b) Social relationships follow the pattern of family relationships.

- Male and female.
- Leader and follower.
- Teacher and students.
- Friends and colleagues.
- Organisation based upon common purpose with partnership, hierarchy, and division of labour. This is the nature of the family. In an effective family, roles, relationships and responsibilities are clear.

5. The family is intended to operate in accordance with natural law.

- a) The family is a microcosm of the cosmos.
- b) The family has biological, social and spiritual underpinnings.
- c) Family relationships are set basically by natural and spiritual law, not social convention. Therefore their root is not human reason, law or custom. They have another source, and are a part of natural law and principle. This is why social strategies fail to halt the breakdown of families.
- d) Families breakdown when a society's laws or customs are violating the principles of true family life. Human strategies to solve this do not address the moral and ethical issues of human relationships, responsibility and purpose. In fact, the question of family breakdown becomes a new occasion for conflict. Attempted remedies tend to increase the social conflict and confusion, which leads to greater breakdown.

6. We can solve social problems when we establish true family life.

- a) True Family Values is a guide to the principles of true family life, which are based upon universal natural and spiritual law.
  - b) True Family Values can help everyone regardless of their religious faith.
  - c) True Family Values builds from the individual to the family, community or hometown, society, nation, world and cosmos.

An excellent article by Neil Clark in the Daily Mail highlighted how money raised from Red Nose Day has been given to organisations such as the International Planned Parenthood Federation, which endorses both extra marital and teenage sex. The USA arm of IPPF has produced a manual for 8 to 12 year olds which states: "Children of this age need a lot of information about safer sex, homosexual, oral and anal sex." A homosexual youth group was awarded £62,000 pounds, and Population Control; an organisation whose projects include working for the implementation of abortion law in countries around the world was awarded £24,000. The Society for the Protection of The Unborn Child was refused a grant! Of course money is given to worthy causes. However, supporting immoral and degrading causes only turns away decent and righteous thinking people. I gave copies of the article to schools and education authorities in my area.

**Testimony by Theresa Quarmby**

*Theresa Quarmby has been an outstanding defender of moral values for many years. She recently stood as a Pro-Life Independent candidate in the recent general election. In the following article she explains what motivates her to always defend moral values in her area, Huddersfield.*

I worked in a doctor's surgery for 30 years and learnt much about family relationships from that experience. In addition to my professional working

life I was involved in the first play groups in Huddersfield and supported voluntary groups visiting and caring for the disabled, elderly and the sick. I was a founding member of the Huddersfield Cyrenians when we used to do soup runs as early as 5 a.m. for those sleeping rough. I support Aid to Africa and also those working for Ethical Treatment for Animals besides two pro-life groups.

Why am I standing as a Pro-Life Independent candidate?

It is because I have watched the disintegration of the family over the past 30 years, and I believe that the State has, over the past 30 years taken over the family, none more so than the present Labour government.

We desperately need to capture the richness of family life – for family life is really about things like celebrating anniversaries, caring for an elderly parent and tucking one's children in bed.

Throughout the ages, political philosophers, social historians, civic and religious leaders have praised the family as the foundation of the social order, the bedrock of nations, and the bastion of civilisation. The 1948 Universal Declaration of Human Rights describes the family as the natural and fundamental group unit of society. The fact is that the family is a universal and irreplaceable community, rooted in human nature and the basis for all societies at all times. As the cradle of life and love for each new generation, the family is the primary source of personal identity, self esteem, and support for children. It is also the first and foremost school of life, uniquely suited to teach children integrity, character, morals, responsibility, service and wisdom.

Given the importance of families to society, we believe that the government should work to support and strengthen families by respecting the well being of families and encouraging healthy marriages and supporting families that need assistance. To support families effectively government must first recognise that families exist apart from the state. The government's obligation is to respect, defend and protect the family as an institution.

The government should keep the tax burden on families as low as possible, and where it is not possible for both parents to be in the paid labour force to provide a household income. We need a public policy to strengthen healthy marriages and where possible a two parent family – research consistently shows that healthy marriages benefit children, adults and society, whereas dysfunctional marriages do not – so we need policies that promote healthy marriages.

The government should recognise that every child has dignity and worth. Present government policies are not educating or benefiting society, they are destroying it, its very foundation has been eroded by liberal policies.

The disaster caused by the government teenage pregnancy strategy is just becoming clear, figures show that 1000 girls aged 14yrs had abortions last year, 148 abortions were performed on girls between 11 and 13 years, and 3,500 girls under 16 terminated their pregnancies.

The number of abortions last year rose by 9%.

It is tragic that a child conceives and bears a child and also a child conceives and then has her child destroyed.

Because of the present condom culture the government is actually sending the message that there is nothing wrong with teenage sex as long as precautions are taken, in fact, they are encouraged to experiment sexually. Once again parental responsibility is undermined as children are being offered abortions without their parents' knowledge.

There is also an urgent problem with STD's which are soaring.

In school children can be given the morning after pill without parental knowledge but they cannot be given an aspirin.

Our children and teenagers are not adult; they are immature and are not able to make wise choices in these matters.

The present government policies amount to a behavioural free for all.

The doctrine of non-judgement has left us with many young casualties to binge drinking, drug taking and sexual promiscuity just to mention a few.

We believe that society teaches our young children the raw mechanics of sex and sexuality; but love, commitment, chastity and self-respect are rarely mentioned. The tragic result of early sexual activity: disease, infertility, pregnancy and abortion are also rarely mentioned.

Our children and grandchildren are so intensely bombarded with immoral political correct teaching that is often difficult for the best loved child to fully understand its long term physical, mental spiritual implications. Most secondary school teachers think that pupils should learn how to get an abortion; we say that this is not what parents send their children to school for.

A recent survey of young teenagers found that instead of being happy with life many were stressed out due to pressure. The pressures they mentioned were, wanting to look like the celebrities, concerns about their weight, alcohol, drugs, broken homes and free sex. Some of the

girls said that they had not been involved in early sexual activity but felt pressured to do so because of school sex lessons. Also some of the girls' parents were having their own problems with partners, drugs and alcohol, so that the only people to turn to for advice were their teenage friends.

Family and marriage are constantly under attack by the present government who I believe have a vision of an all embracing paternalistic state.

We now have civil partnerships. Homosexual couples have the right to adopt children and claim to raise children who are as developmentally normal as those from traditional homes. Additionally the incidence of domestic violence among gay men is nearly double that in the heterosexual population. These are not the conditions of a healthy home or lifestyle.

Doctors have given a warning over a virulent multi-drug resistant strain of HIV that can trigger full blown Aids within 4 months of infection.

Two years ago it was reported that some infants were entering school and were not toilet trained nor did they know how to use a knife and fork. This year it is said that some infants don't know how to communicate or even talk properly, and are badly behaved. So the government came up with classes to teach primary school children how to be nice. Children will be given lessons on how to express feelings such as anger, jealousy and regret and be encouraged to forgive classmates.

The Dept. of Education have told Head teachers that they can no longer assume that the development of social and emotional skills is the responsibility of parents because of the breakdown of family life, higher divorce rates and subsequently one parent families.

Nick Seaton, the chairman of the campaign for real education called the initiative absolute psychobabble. He said parents do not send their children to school to have them talking about their emotions, they sent them to learn, write and add-up. Yet again this is the nanny state attempting to take away the responsibility of parents. There has been much comment in the press that no government in British history has interfered in aspects of our lives as this present government.

Back in 1969 the late Malcolm Muggeridge addressed a rally in Bournemouth and in his speech said that since we had just legalised abortion, we were on a slippery slope which would inevitably lead to the deliberate killing of the old and infirm. We have duly arrived at that point. Lord

Joffe admits that his aim is not only to establish the RIGHT of a group of people to choose to die by euthanasia. His bill is the first step in an incremental approach to introduce voluntary euthanasia for all. If we don't speak out society will eventually lose all respect for human life.

Meanwhile we now know that many women are stressed and unhappy trying to hold a full time job and care for a husband and children. Often women are struggling, exhausted and disillusioned. Is this another failed social experiment?

To bring this all together we need to strengthen the family. Many one parent families are also a source of comfort and reassurance. I was one such family, yet a family with a mum and dad who are committed to marriage and devote themselves to their children helps provide children with a sound foundation for success. Government can support families by promoting policies that help strengthen the institution of marriage and helps parents rear their children in positive and healthy environments.
