



The path we must go in accordance with God's Will

Cheon Seong Gyeong: Book 8 Life of Faith and Training, Section 3, The Path of Faith



True Father's Message (May 17, 2007 - 25th anniversary of The Washington Times)

hen we talk about the true path of faith, "true" means there is only one path. What then, is the object of our faith? It is the absolute God. A life of faith is about seeking and finding the destination of hope desired by God, in accordance with His Will. A life of faith is not about what I want; it is not about the desire of those who lead a life of faith. Confusion has occurred within the global community of faith because people have not understood that a life of faith should be centered upon accomplishing God's Will, not centered upon oneself.

Everything depends on oneself. It is up to each of us whether we achieve perfection or fail to achieve it. It is the same regarding whether we succeed or fail in life. Our life of faith is no different. Although our faith may be constant throughout our life, our conscience urges us to strive after ever-higher goals. Reaching the highest standard is, however, no ordinary undertaking. The higher we climb, the closer to the peak we are, until ultimately we realize that everything ends in unity. It is difficult, though, to reach that point of oneness: historically, our conscience has sought the purpose of goodness, yet the

perfection we desire as human beings still eludes us.

In the Unification Church, your life of faith requires you to raise the standard by which you evaluate yourselves as you walk with God in your daily lives. When you go to the spirit world this higher standard will be your asset. It will also be the determining factor deciding whether in the new era you will be remembered in history as a hero or an outcast.

Each one of us needs a victorious standard, a starting point from which we can accomplish our

mission. This means we must establish a victorious standard from the subject partner position. Naturally, unless we establish a victorious standard, we will not be able to accomplish our purpose. Where must we establish this standard? It must be created within ourselves.

When Jesus came to earth carrying God's entire mission on His behalf, standing as the one responsible for ending a cosmic struggle, the issue for Jesus was always to focus on his relationship with God. God was to be the center of heaven and earth and Jesus the substantial center. Jesus was constantly mindful of this fact. If any gap between himself and God had opened, or a conflict over their purpose had arisen, they would not have been able to progress toward victory.

Deep in his heart, Jesus carried the conviction that the Father and Son must always be united. In other words, centering on God, the victorious subject partner, Jesus was fully aware that in order to prepare a victorious foundation as a subject partner on earth, he needed to attend God in his heart. It is from this standpoint that Jesus referred to himself as the temple of God. Achieving a victorious standard means to create a foundation of unity, of becoming a temple centering on Jesus, the substantial manifestation of God on earth. In other words, to complete a victorious foundation, a standard must be established. Otherwise the completion of restoration, the accomplishment of Jesus' mission, would be impossible. Therefore, unless we establish a standard of faith and begin, we cannot claim that we have attained a victorious foundation. This is true no matter how long we have practiced a life of faith or how difficult our course may have been. In conclusion, the most important point is to have one moment that defines the standard of victory within oneself.

When you seek what is true, you need a heart that longs for what is true. When you yearn for the truth in which heaven and earth can take delight, you must realize that you have to prepare yourself to match the standard of what is true from Heaven's perspective. The true God, true truth and true human beings are different kinds of existences. However, from an internal point of view, all three move in the same direction. In other words, God and truth move in one direction and coexist eternally. When we look at today's world, we lament that this world has not become a true world. Furthermore, when we look deeply within ourselves, we lament not becoming true people and deplore not finding the true God in our lives of faith, despite yearning to do so. This is the agony faced by those who lead a life of faith.

No one who lives a life of faith at the risk of his or her life wants to see

his or her faith simply crumble amid life's tribulations. The more seriously we practice our faith, the greater the trials we encounter and the more we want our faith to become deeper, wider and more enduring. If God is a serious God, then when He looks at each of us, we want Him to look more seriously at us than others look at us. Furthermore, as believers we all desire to leave a legacy in this world related to the cause most dear to our hearts.

As believers, we say we will become God's children. Yet what is God's wish? God's ultimate wish for us has nothing to do with the mundane matters of our daily lives such as eating and sleeping. These activities are common to everyone. The Bible clearly tells us, "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear?' For it is the Gentiles who strive for all these things... But strive first for the kingdom of God and His righteousness." (Matt.6:31-33)

A life of faith involves overcoming the constraints of our environment, making breakthroughs every day and constantly seeking new paths. Unless we do so, we cannot enter the kingdom desired by God. Since we often lack energy and since our habits and daily lives do not meet a high standard on our path of faith, we need to uphold God as our standard and adjust our daily lives accordingly. To

Do not forget that you are among the central ranks

irst of all, I think it is our pressing task to let all the people in the world know, within the shortest time possible, that the True Parents have come. Telling humankind that True Parents have already come will become our great asset in the future. We have already finished the Completed Testament Age and ushered in Cheon II Guk. Yet, these people live without knowing the providential time.

We cannot remain still. We should mobilize all means to notify people that True Parents have come. We must inform them that the Messiah has come.

None of these things come to pass just by talking. They are not fulfilled just by proclaiming them. Rather, you must act, create motion, and harvest fruits. You must think about how to ignite church activities through witnessing. The Jewish people have the concept that they are the chosen people, but their history up until Jesus came was miserable. Israel itself was unable to follow a smooth path in that era. Its people followed a path of life-or-death resolution.

That being the case, Heaven could establish only one center to carry out His work. As He raised Israel to become the central providential nation, God sent many prophets through the ages, allowed their people to survive, and then sent Jesus to them. But what happened? The people of Israel, who had been placed in a difficult environment, believed that the Savior and Messiah promised by Heaven would come in great splendor. They believed that when he appeared, everything they had desired would be fulfilled overnight, that the tides of the world would change in their favor. They thought that Israel would stand tall and bring Rome to ruin and that there would be other such miracles, but these things did not happen.

We should be grateful and express appreciation to True Parents. Through the word, we came to understand the principles of indemnity, and discovered that we could not move forward without passing through the principle of restoration through indemnity. The reason I frequently watch the Cheon II Guk Foundation Day video is because you too must stand in the realm of heart as True Parents do, and live within that same realm of heart. From True Parents' point of view, the children of the True Family are the same as you regarding this point. From now, as long as I live, I shall build up Heaven's tradition so that you and the True Family can stand upright within the same realm of heart as True Parents.

If your viewpoint of the providence becomes clouded, make a new resolution while watching the Foundation Day events video again. You must work and live as if a day is a thousand years. You will not be able to say that you were unable to do this because you didn't know. I have told you and taught you everything.

You must all wake up and pay attention. If all 7 billion people in the world go to the spirit world without ever hearing about the news that True Parents have come, what do you think they will say to you in the spirit world? You and I both breathed the same air and lived in the same era as True Parents. Yet, why didn't you tell us about True Parents? Why didn't you introduce them to us? If I had known True Parents, I would have attended them much better than you did. You will be subject to such accusations for eternity. If you fail to fulfill your mission of telling people about the True Parents, you will not be able to escape such accusations.

I wish to have you all stand in the position of loyalty, piety and fidelity. In order to do that, you must unite with what I say. I don't mean that you should just talk about standing in a position of loyalty, piety and fidelity. You must practice this through your actions. Those in leadership positions should encourage others to do this. Do not forget that you are among the central ranks. The True Family has the same mission. If those children born of True Parents' direct lineage are unable to think about humankind, they will end up in a place where they receive eternal accusation.

Through these meetings with missionaries and youth across America, Continental Director Dunkley provided opportunities for youth to deepen their faith, reflect on the importance of witnessing activities, and established a significant turning point in strengthening their faithful dedication and sense of mission.

'Peace Starts With Me' Music Masterclass: A Transformative Experience

rom October 18-19, 100 people participated in the Peace Starts With Me Music Masterclass on the East Coast. The New Jersey Family Church hosted the program which featured Minister A. Curtis Farrow as music director extraordinaire! The program focused on experiencing the Holy Spirit through music. Participants ranged from 10 years old to 71 years old. People arrived at 6pm on Friday and practiced for 4 hours. The following day, practice went from 10AM to 6PM and it was intense. People who came for the experience and thought they couldn't sing learned that they are amazing singers!

On October 20, 402 people gathered for the East Coast National Sunday Service message given by President Demian Dunkley, Regional Chair and National President for the American Movement. Near the end of service, the power in the entire neighborhood went out but Minister Farrow kept the choir singing a cappella and people supported them with a phone light wave.

On October 25, members from across the Western Region gathered at the Los Angeles Family Church for the West Coast Peace Starts With Me (PSWM) Music Masterclass led by Minister Curtis Farrow. There was excitement in the air, and also nervousness since 104 people consisting of 71 youth and 33 elder-generation had no musical or choir experience before. The masterclass became a learning experience.

Participants learned and practiced five Christian-based songs. Rev. Dunkley emphasized how this experience was exactly what True Mother asked him to do: together with Christianity, create new songs for this new era! Minster Farrow spent more time here teaching internal content to give participants a chance to figure out how to tune-in to the Holy Spirit, focusing more on that than sounding perfect musically. All of the lessons interjected during practice were direct reflections of exactly how we should be crafting our relationship and awareness of True Mother. Minister Farrow taught True Mother's love in a most heartistic way. With only one and a half days of practice and after many tears were shed, the choir arrived on Sunday morning for the National Sunday Service broadcasted live throughout America with 300 people attending in person and 1000+ viewing online.

At the beginning of service, people shot up from their seats, standing with the spirit that was being poured out by the choir; the audience was so caught in the spirit that they did not sit down for the rest of the service, even during the sermon!

Rev. Dunkley gave a message of homecoming saying:

"I know it's not easy because sometimes I feel I am not worthy. . . But there are people who need you. And whether you are at step 10, step 5, or step 1, I promise you, you are paving the way for someone who is behind you following you! Whether you are bright and shiny and taking that step towards God, or whether you are 10 steps behind but still taking that one step towards God, that one step is the same step! That step has the same power! It inspires people! You can save people's lives!"

By the end, Unificationists and their new friends and guests were in tears. The West Coast Masterclass proved to me a transformative experience of family, friendship and love.

Finally, on November 2-3, the Holy Spirit Peace Starts With Me Choir Movement came to Washington D.C. from November 2-3 bringing together 130 participants from the D.C., Maryland, and Virginia (DMV) areas. Love and excitement were bubbling forth as people of all ages and nationalities began to assemble. Minister Farrow, Emmy Award Winning Producer and Director of McDonald's Gospel Fest established voice placements and began molding the beautiful array of young and old into one united voice singing traditional gospel hymns, and one of his original songs.

The event marked the 79th anniversary of the liberation of the Mauthausen concentration camp and the end of World War II, coinciding with various commemorative events throughout Austria.

UPF Chairman Hans Rechberger, serving as MC, emphasized the importance of a 'culture of remembrance' in his opening address. He stated that "True peace must be founded on True Parents' words of 'living for the sake of others,' and we must move forward on the path of love and reconciliation for peace."

The program continued with a peace prayer led by a Catholic priest of St. Francis, followed by remarks from the Mayor of Parndorf. The mayor addressed the current crisis situation in Europe and emphasized the importance of reconciliation, noting that "small efforts together can lead to big changes."

The event concluded with a moving performance by the Parndorf Tamburizza Orchestra, which elevated the atmosphere and deeply touched all attendees.

Three mayors from nearby villages joined the festival, along with local leaders, various politicians, and more than 50 Parndorf residents who shared messages of peace and reconciliation. This festival built upon a memorial event held the previous year for Parndorf victims of National Socialism, where Johann Rechberger had contributed with an exhibition about women under the Nazi regime at the local school, which was attended by over 100 locals. The local newspaper featured a full-page article about the event, helping to spread its message of peace and remembrance. \mathcal{T}









Family Peace Festival Unites Faiths in Switzerland

he Family Peace Festival, held on November 16, 2024, in Biel/Bienne, Switzerland, brought together diverse religious communities for an afternoon of celebration and interfaith dialogue. The event, organized by the FFWPU and UPF, marked the culmination of three months of outreach and preparation with UPA and Swiss missionaries.

The festival, hosted in a grand concert hall, opened with performances by second-generation families, Ambassadors for Peace, and community members. The highlight was an interreligious panel discussion on the theme "Peace starts with me and my family," moderated by Chantal Chételat Komagata, Secretary General of UPF Switzerland. She summarized the "Principles for sustainable peace and happiness," emphasizing the importance of filial and fraternal relationships in building lasting peace.

The panel featured six diverse religious representatives: Koffi Owoussi representing African traditional religions demonstrated unity through an engaging nail puzzle; Martin Kamber shared Buddhist wisdom on inner peace; Jacques Villoz of the Latter Day Saints discussed family

peace through personal experience; medical student Ghoufrane Beltifa read Korean passages about love and unity; Martin Wolf offered Krishna perspectives; and Rosa Hänseler presented Biblical insights on women's development and SDGs. The panelists concluded by performing a symbolic water ceremony, representing each faith's contribution to peace.

The event culminated in a Peace Blessing ceremony officiated by Nathalie Komagata and Thomas Pritty, which included traditional elements such as the holy wine ceremony and a ritual to overcome gender-based resentment. The celebration concluded with the cutting of a handmade cake by Hwayeon Lee and a Middle Eastern feast.

According to one participant's testimony, the festival successfully demonstrated how different religious communities could unite around common values, particularly regarding family. The event highlighted the vibrant and youthful nature of Biel's religious communities while showcasing how interfaith cooperation can contribute to societal peace and harmony. To


The 2024 Peace Road event concluded with a closing ceremony presided over by the association president.
