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## Our Master's Second Visit to the United States

Our Master and His Party arrived at San Francisco on Feb. 5th in the early morning. Master's party consisted of Our Real Mother, Mrs. Chei, Mr. Rhyu, the President of the Holy Spirit Association of Korea and Mr. Kuboki from Japan. This was the beginning of the 2nd world tour.

Vernon Pearson and John Schmidli represented the N. W. family and they were ready to welcome His party at the S.F. airport on His arrival. Maxine Adamson joined them on Feb. 6th.

Master's party left San Francisco on Feb. 7 for Los Angeles and then flew to Washington, D.C. All the West Coast family had the honor to hear Him speak and chat with Him during His stay in the S.F. area.

Miss Y. O. Kim, one of 3 Pioneer Korean missionaries in our movement, came to S.F. a few days before His party arrived.

This time Our Master and Real Mother will bless a certain number of American couples in Principle in the Sacred Marriage at Washington, D.C.

Some impressions of our N.W. Family members when meeting our Master and His party are as follows:

Vernon Pearson; Portland, Oregon:

After meeting Master I had many feelings--one feeling was that I wanted to tell Him that I didn't mind being faithful to the Principle message for over 9 years. That I was glad I could be of some help but I wish I could have done more. Another feeling was that I really had found my True Parents for the first time.

While I was sitting at Master's table Wednesday night, He said to me something like:

"I remember you in my mind several times when you were staying in the basement house in Boise, Idaho."

Then a few moments later Mother Moon said to me something like:

"Vernon I feel like I know you well. You do not seem like a stranger to me."

Early the next morning (4:30 a.m.) I woke up and cried because I felt so terribly unworthy. Still a 3rd feeling was that Master may soon judge me with His Word. I do not know what He will say but in many ways I feel so incomplete, so terribly unworthy.

Such compassion and understanding, gentleness of heart, a firmness of mind and the eloquence of simplicity, and the quality of serenity--of give and take that was so plainly visible between Master and Mrs. Chei.
