A message from our regional president on the current situation in the Middle East and ways that we can help as a global community..

Dear Family,

Over the last few days Fumiko and I, and probably all of us have been watching in near despair as the violence in the Middle East has gone from worse to worse. We may understand some of the political, geographical and historical complexities involved, but one thing is sure: everywhere, too many people are dying. And all of them are our Heavenly Parent's children.

I've been in contact today with our FFWPU Lebanon National Leaders, Rev. Jongin and Yola Park, and Middle East SubRegional Leader Umberto Angelucci. The good news is that so far, all of our members and families are safe, by the grace of God. Yet almost everyone knows someone who is not safe. Thousands and thousands of families are displaced, and the Beirut schools are now shelters suddenly filling up with homeless families. Our center has already welcomed one family who had to suddenly leave from the South just before their neighbourhood was bombed, and we expect more families will come soon.

Our young people in Beirut are of course worried and afraid. Yet, they would like to immediately go out and serve others. They want to go out into the neighbourhood community and distribute food, fruit and clothing and other much needed supplies, and share their love and encouragement. The need is enormous, but our resources are very few. At the moment, none of our families can even go to work as normal. Without our help, they cannot do so much.

Our family in the Middle East is not new to this - they did the same at the time of the big explosion in Beirut a few years ago. They distributed relief supplies and rebuilt a school in Turkey after the devastating earthquake of 2023; and we assisted the Red Cross with the floods in Libya and the earthquake in Morocco in the same year. At those times, our families in Europe rallied together and gave generously.

Today, we asking every community to do the same. To start with, this Sunday, let's take up an additional collection on behalf of our relief efforts. Or you can make your own donation using the details below.
