

Erasmus+ Exchange in Helsinki, Finland


From October 8th to 14th, 2024, YSP Balkan, in partnership with Helsinki YMCA and supported by UBT High School, organized a transformative Erasmus+ exchange program for 15 students and staff members. The 7-day experience featured impactful workshops and interactive sessions focused on youth leadership, peacebuilding, and social inclusion through sports. Participants were inspired by Helsinki YMCA's innovative use of sports as a tool for community engagement and integration, gaining invaluable insights into youth-driven initiatives for positive change. The program also offered a rich cultural exchange, as participants immersed themselves in Finnish traditions while building meaningful connections with their Helsinki peers. This initiative highlighted the profound role of collaboration and intercultural dialogue in empowering young leaders across borders.



YSP UK: 56km Sponsored Walk for YSP Lebanon

Between September 29 and October 13, YSP UK organized a 56km sponsored walk spanning London, Wales, and Slovakia to raise funds for YSP Lebanon, supporting displaced civilians in Beirut with essential supplies like milk and blankets. Volunteers Sophia Nicholls, Grace Mvika, Elliot Yamamoto, Bedrixan, and Alma Gaina shared the challenge, surpassing their initial goal by raising £1,245 through a GoFundMe campaign, exceeding their target of £750.

This initiative aligned with several UN SDGs, including SDG 2 (Zero Hunger), SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-Being), SDG 16 (Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions), and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals). The funds, sent to Lebanon via Western Union, will support projects addressing urgent community needs. Beyond raising funds, the team collaborated with YSP Lebanon to ensure effective delivery of aid and engaged their communities to raise awareness about Beirut's ongoing humanitarian crisis.



Peacebuilding Through Language: YSP Moldova's "My Planet" Activity

On October 4th, 2024, Youth and Students for Peace Moldova hosted a peacebuilding event at the Peace Embassy in Chisinau, bringing together nine participants for a unique blend of education and friendship-building. Through the interactive game "My Planet", participants practiced their English communication skills by sharing personal stories and aspirations, fostering connections and cultural understanding.

Aligned with SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-being) and SDG 4 (Quality Education), the event used non-formal education methods to create a supportive, engaging atmosphere. Supported by the Family Federation for Peace and Unification Moldova, the program was made possible through the efforts of volunteers Cornelia, Dayvid, and Viorica, who facilitated activities, managed logistics, and prepared refreshments.




Congratulations, YSP Balkan! A Resounding Success at S!NERGY 2024 🞉

YSP Balkan has once again made an incredible impact, shining brightly at S!NERGY 2024! With an exceptional 57.14% of all projects presented hailing from Kosovo, North Macedonia and a remarkable 40% of participants coming from the Western Balkans (Kosovo, Albania, Serbia, and North Macedonia), WB region has proven to be a powerhouse of youth innovation and leadership.

Kicking off with an inspiring visit to the Vienna International United Nations Center, 13 young leaders from Kosovo and North Macedonia, alongside peers from across Europe and the Middle East, gained firsthand insights into global policymaking. Guided by Jeong-hye Yeom, IAYSP EUME's representative at the UN, our delegation showcased the immense potential of youth on the international stage.

The momentum continued at the S!NERGY Assembly in Budapest, where YSP Balkan participants captivated audiences with their visionary ideas, supported by steadfast partners like UBT University, UBT High School, and the University of Tetovo.



YSP Brno Celebrates All Saints' Day with Reflection and Community

On November 1, 2024, YSP Brno hosted a reflective gathering for All Saints' Day, bringing together 11 participants for an evening focused on spirituality and remembrance. The event featured an opening speech by Artem, followed by a lecture from Marie Sale on how different cultures honor the departed, including Dia de los Muertos, Halloween, and Samhain.

Participants then took part in a commemorative ritual, lighting candles and reflecting on their loved ones. This was followed by a group discussion on the nature of souls and spirituality, fostering mutual respect and curiosity. The evening ended with socializing and board games, strengthening the community bonds. The gathering successfully created a meaningful space for reflection and connection.



IAYSP Lebanon Supports Displaced Families in Beirut

On October 17, 2024, IAYSP Lebanon, in collaboration with LP4Y, Mission Village, and Play for Peace, organized two impactful humanitarian activities in Beirut to assist families displaced by the ongoing conflict. The first activity, held at Mission Village, saw LP4Y volunteers cooking and serving meals for 100 displaced individuals. After sharing lunch, the team distributed meals to families living in tents on the streets.


The second activity, hosted at Play for Peace, engaged 30 children in games and activities designed to bring joy and a sense of normalcy. The children and their mothers expressed deep gratitude, with mothers especially appreciative of the opportunity for their kids to participate in such uplifting activities.


