They will demonstrate the model of offering the first three-tenths of their income for public purposes. This cannot be an imposed tax; it has to be a gift that citizens offer willingly to heaven with joyful hearts.

With this in mind, please give your Holy Day offerings as generously and as promptly as you can. One suggestion: add a little bit extra to the recommended €80 for individuals or €120 for families. On the Day of All True Things, we show our gratitude to God for the good things in life, given freely to all of us despite our shortcomings. Let us in turn love and be generous to everyone, and invite as many people as we can from among our neighbours and friends to join us in this festival of thanksgiving.
