To about 35 participants of the gathering she reported many interesting aspects of her life, mainly about her long standing dedication for the WFWP all around the world.

Her work for women brought her together with many important

personalities in East and West. She conducted the first sisterhood ceremony with all together 160.000 couples from Korea and Japan. Another Bridge of Peace between USA and Japan took place in 1996 with President George Bush sen. and his wife Barbara.

Her investment for "Empowering of Women" was very well recognized by UN Secretary General Ban Ki-Moon.

She presented many impressive pictures of her extraordinary encounters with important personalities from around the world and from all fields of society. Her close relationship to the founder of WFWP, Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, also came out clearly through many personal photos.

Many decades Dr. Lan-Young Moon worked as well for Global Women's Peace Network. To build a network of the motherly heart is her utmost concern. She also founded the "1% Love Sharing" project after she had seen the big suffering of families in North Korea during her many visits there.

Because she has seen much suffering of women and mothers around the world in all these years, it is still a big concern for her to strengthen the women and their families.

Also she showed us pictures of her own three sons and three grandchildren that are her great pride.



Together with her husband, Dr. No Hi Pak, she works now as a special advisor in Europe, visited families and places of interest in Upper Bavaria, such as the highest mountain in Germany, the Zugspitze.
