5. Others

- A. All staff who participate the full 21 day period will be considered to have attended a Cheongpyeong 21-day Workshop.
- B. The Training Center will cover the full 21-day registration fee of all staff expect for International University Students Workshop team leaders. The University team leaders need to pay the general 21-day workshop fee (380,000 won) but other special expenses for this workshop will covered by the Training Center. This is because University team leaders will have more time as a participant compared to other staff.
- C. The number of staff we recruit might change according to the number of participants.
- D. Even if you are initially selected as a staff, if you cannot attend the Staff Preparation Workshop, you might be asked to step down. In such a case, you will have to pay the full registration fee to attend the 21-day workshop.
- E. All members coming from abroad need to apply for Medical Insurance for Traveling Abroad (Traveler's Insurance) before attending a Cheongpyeong workshop. Please make sure with the company that it can be used in South Korea. Please note that even if you obtain traveler's insurance, if you receive medical treatment at the hospital you will be asked to pay the hospital fee first and you will be reimbursed later, so you will need extra cash for emergency medical expenses.
- F. Members must come to Korea with a VISA which is valid throughout the whole stay. The Training Center cannot acquire or extend visas for you. If your visa expires while you are in Korea, the immigration office will charge you a penalty and your name will likely be placed on a blacklist.
