BELARUS. INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S PEACE CONFERENCE

On October 14, the 5th Annual Women's Peace Conference "The Role of Women in Building the Culture of Peace" was held in Vitebsk city of Belarus. It was dedicated to the Mother's Day in Belarus. This conference was organized by Belarus Peace Fond, WFPW of Japan, Belarus and Russia and social organization "Family world". Conference gathered over 50 representatives of governmental institutions and NGOs of Belarus, participants from Russia, Moldova and Japan. Many of guests said that they were very moved by most of the speeches because they could practically discuss how to contribute to world peace even in one's daily life.

The conference was followed by a traditional Bridge of Peace ceremony that gave opportunity to women of different nationalities to become sisters.

As part of the program there were also performances by Belarus children's ensemble "Assol" and Russian children's ensemble "Angels of Peace". Before and after the conference the Angels of Peace ensemble gave a charity concert for disabled children at the boarding school for deaf children and in the orphanage of Vitebsk.
