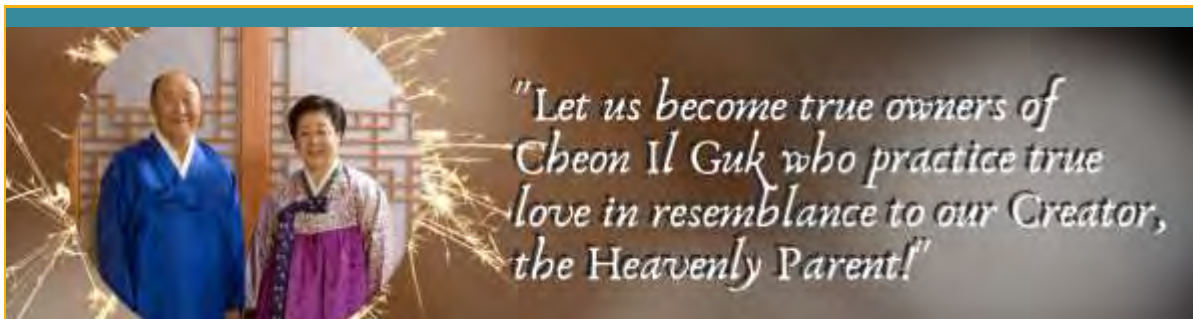


Clifton, NJ Family Church: Pastor's Letter and Ignite Our Passions Summit

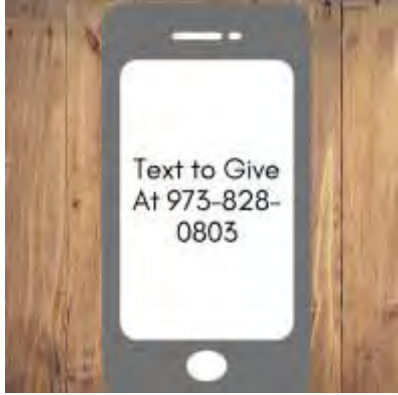
