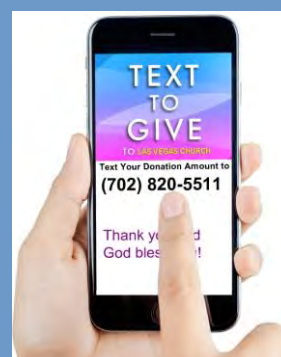
The original email is below with the international memo.

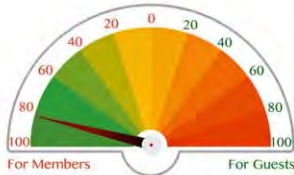
