

FFWPU DR Congo: Renewal Through Sanctification and Purification

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On Sunday, June 7, 2026, members of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) of Kinshasa gathered for their weekly Sunday service in an atmosphere filled with spirituality, meditation, and inner renewal.
