

FFWPU Côte d'Ivoire: National Offering of Divine Principle Seminars

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As part of the 40-Day Period of Global Devotion, the National Education Department of FFWPU-Côte d'Ivoire organized a profound series of 7-day and 21-day Divine Principle seminars from July 27 to August 24, 2026. Held at the National Education Center in Yopougon, Abidjan, and the Education Center in Yamoussoukro, these seminars represented the nation's spiritual offering to Heaven.

Matching the providential number 40, exactly 40 participants registered across the special devotion period.

Key Seminar Highlights and Participation

Abidjan (Economic Capital): From August 3 to 9, 27 participants completed the 7-day Divine Principle seminar at the Yopougon Center. Additionally, 13 participants began a 21-day workshop running from August 3 to August 24.

Yamoussoukro (Political Capital): A dedicated 21-day seminar was held for the Second Generation from July 27 to August 9, bringing together 13 young participants.

Graduation Ceremony: The closing event in Yopougon was honored by the presence of the National Leader of FFWPU-Côte d'Ivoire.

Providential Breakthroughs and Devotion A significant highlight from the 7-day workshop in Abidjan was the participation of Pastor Iré Teba Pierre Harris, founder of seven major Christian churches in Côte d'Ivoire. Deeply moved by the teachings, Pastor Harris committed to integrating the Divine Principle into the curriculum of all his churches.

Reflecting on the symbolism of the number 13 - marking 13 years of Cheon Il Guk, True Father's 13 years in the spiritual realm, and the 13-year sentence requested by the prosecutor against True Mother - the community continues to offer heartfelt devotions for the 13 participants completing their 21-day seminar in Yopougon.

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
