

Bold Enkhjargal's Testimony at the Pure Water Assembly 2026

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A courageous young leader from Mongolia reflects on his transformative experience at the 2026 Pure Water Assembly, hosted at the CheonBo Training Center from August 13 to 26.

Good morning everyone.

My name is Bold Enkhjargal. I am 18 years old, and I am a 2nd Generation Blessed Child from Mongolia.

Before this workshop, I did not really see myself as a child of Heavenly Parent. I saw myself as an ordinary teenager, simply trying to find my way in life. I knew about True Parents and Heavenly Parent, but I did not truly understand how deeply They loved me. To be honest, I even thought, "I don't want to go to the Pure Water Workshop."

But something changed in the middle of July. I had a dream about my grandfather. He told me: "You need to move forward. You need to study and educate yourself. You need to surround yourself with positive people. Go and recharge yourself. You are not trying hard enough. You need to try."
