On September 20th, the Birmingham branch of Universal Peace Federation (UPF) UK, and the Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP), hosted a 1-day Principles of Peace seminar. The programme brought together around 135 participants, including more than 30 first-time guests, Ambassadors for Peace, and a broad range of faith leaders representing the Christian, Muslim, Sikh and Hindu traditions.

The seminar reflected UPF UK's mission to build a culture of peace through interfaith dialogue, family values, and community cohesion, embracing people of diverse faiths, cultures, races and ethnicities.

Principles of Peace and One Family under God

We were honoured to welcome Dr David Hanna, former UPF North Region President, as the keynote presenter. Drawing upon sacred scriptures from many faiths, as well as the words of UPF co-founders, Father and Mother Moon, Dr Hanna highlighted the vision of One Family under God as the foundation for peace. His presentations explored the link between strong families, good citizenship, and lasting peace, key themes in UPF's philosophy and peacebuilding work.
