


God's Heart

Proposed HSA-UWC (Unification Church) Religious Emblem Program

The religious emblem program found in this manual was developed in 1994 by Gary Fleisher to meet the requirements of the Boy Scouts of America religious emblem program. Due to lack of approval from the then USA HQ for HSA-UWC (Unification Church), the program was never finalized. It is offered here for its historical significance and educational value for the young people of the Unification Church/Family Federation for World Peace.

What is the God's Heart Program

The God's Heart program, is a religious emblem program, created for Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, or Explorers.

To earn the God's Heart emblem you will serve others, and learn about our Heavenly Father, True Parents, and the Unification Church. When you have earned the God's Heart emblem, you will have earned more than a medal. You will have moved our world closer to Heavenly Father, and become a more mature person yourself.

How Do I Earn the God's Heart?

1. Talk to your parents about earning the God's Heart. With their help, find a counselor. The counselor should be someone who is, or is approved by your Unification Church Leader. Any Local, City, State, Regional, or National Unification Church Leader can approve your counselor. Your counselor will help you accomplish the requirements of the God's Heart. Your counselor may work with you alone, or with a group of candidates for the God's Heart.

Your counselor may replace God's Heart requirements with other requirements. They may modify or add requirements. Your counselor and your parents will certify that you have earned the God's Heart.

2. Get a notebook. You will use this notebook to fulfill the requirements for the God's Heart. You will keep the notebook. It will not be sent in after you have completed the God's Heart requirements.
3. With your counselor and parents fulfill the requirements of the God's Heart program.

4. Have your parents and counselor sign the enclosed God's Heart Completion Form, certifying that you have earned the God's Heart. Mail the form. Ask your counselor to mail the form to: Gary Fleisher, Unification Church Religious Emblem Committee.
5. You will receive the God's Heart Certificate and/or Medal at a church meeting.

Requirements for the God's Heart Program

Do requirement I, II, III, IV, and V. Your counselor may wish to replace some requirements with others. If there is a reason why you can't do a requirement, talk to your counselor. They can change or modify the requirement to fit your special needs.

The Heart of God and True Parents

I. The Heart of God

- A. In your notebook, explain what was God's purpose for creating Man?
- B. In your notebook explain how God felt when the first humans fell?
- C. In your notebook explain how and why God worked so hard to restore man after the fall?
- D. In your notebook explain how can you ease God's suffering?

II. The Value of True Parents

- A. In your notebook, explain what "True Parents" means to Unification Church members?
- B. In your notebook explain how Reverend and Mrs. Moon became True Parents?
- C. In your notebook explain how can you become a True Parent?
- D. Write, tape record, or video tape your own news program about what the True Parents have done, what organizations they have founded, etc.
- E. Tell at least three people who are not members of the Unification Church about the value of True

Parents and the Unification Church. (Witness to three people.) Record your experiences in your notebook.

III. The Position of Blessed Children

- A. In your notebook explain: what it means to be a Blessed Child?
- B. Explain how you should relate to children who are not Unification Church members.
- C. Serve children who are not members of the Unification Church. Give at least 21 hours of service by doing service projects. Some examples of service projects might be: become a volunteer tutor or library assistant, help a Cub Scout pack that is not sponsored by the Unification Church, become a volunteer at a children's hospital that is not a Unification Church institution, clean school grounds of a non-Unification Church school, help a non-Unification Church food drive, etc. Keep a log of your service in your notebook.
- D. Serve your local Unification Church congregation. Give at least 21 hours of service to your local church. At least seven of the hours should be spent in fund raising for the church. Some examples of other service might be: ushering, cleaning or repairing the church, visiting sick or infirmed members of the congregation, help a youth organization associated with the Unification Church, helping prepare for church activities, or helping with mailings. Ask your local church leader for his help in fund raising and serving the congregation. Keep a log of your service in your notebook. Explain the internal reasons for fund raising in your notebook.

IV. Divine Principle

- A. In your notebook, explain what the Divine Principle is, and where it came from.
- B. Give a Divine Principle Lecture to an audience of at least three people.
- C. Write about the lecture in your notebook.

V. Dating, Sex, and Marriage

- A. In your notebook explain why Unification Church members don't date, and what you should do, if someone asks you for a date.
- B. In your notebook explain the importance of sexual purity and God's original intention for sex.
- C. How do Unification Church members select mates.
- D. Explain what Holy Marriage is, why it exists, and why it is different from other marriages.

- E. Interview at least two Blessed Couples, and ask them about what Blessed Marriage means to them.

Do requirement VI or requirement VII. If you wish to do both you may, however, only one is required.

VI. The Bible

- A. In your notebook explain what the Bible is, how it was written, and who wrote it.
- B. Visit a religious institution that believes in the Bible, such as a church or synagogue. Ask a leader of that institution to explain his religion.
- C. In your notebook, explain what you learned from your visit. List some of the differences and similarities between the Unification Church and the institution that you visited.

VII. Other Holy Books

- A. Choose a holy book, other than the Bible, that is the primary scripture of a religion, such as the Koran. In your notebook explain about that scripture, how it was written, who wrote it, etc.
- B. Visit a religious institution that believes in the scripture that you selected, such as a mosque. Ask a leader of that institution to explain his religion.
- C. In your notebook, explain what you learned from your visit. List some of the differences and similarities between the Unification Church and

the institution that you visited.

Do requirement VIII or requirement IX. If you wish to do both you may, however, only one is required.

VIII. Holy Days

- A. In your notebook list the major holy days of the Unification Church.
- B. Choose one Holy Day, and, in your notebook, explain why it exists, how it came to be, and how it is celebrated.
- C. In your notebook, explain the differences between the way the Holy Day you selected and Christmas are celebrated.

IX. True Parent's Picture, the Unification Symbol, and the Unification Church Flag

- A. In your notebook explain the importance and use of True Parent's picture.
- B. Get your own picture of True Parent's, and demonstrate it's use and care.
- C. In your notebook explain what the parts of the Symbol of the Unification Church stand for.
- D. In your notebook describe the Unification Church flag, and it's proper use.

Choose two requirements from X, XI, XII, XIII, XIV, XV, XVI and do them. For instance you could do requirement X and XV. Your counselor may want you to do more than two requirements. Your counselor may select, change, or modify the requirements.

X. Prayer

- A. Explain how, why and when to pray.
- B. What does it mean to pray in the name of True Parent's. How is that different than praying in the name of Jesus?

- C. Hold a prayer vigil, beginning at midnight, and ending at 4:00 am.

XI. Pledge Service

- A. Explain why, when and how we do the Pledge Service.
- B. Lead a pledge service.

XII. Sunday Service

- A. Explain why, when and how we have Sunday Church Service.
- B. Give a talk at a Sunday Service.

XIII. Holy Salt

- A. Explain where Holy Salt comes from and what it's purpose and use are.
- B. Demonstrate the use of Holy Salt.
- C. Attend a ceremony to multiply Holy Salt.

XIV. Holy Ground

- A. Explain what a Holy Ground is, why it is made, how it is made, what is a good place for a Holy Ground, and who may make a Holy Ground.
- B. Visit a Holy Ground and explain it's history.

XV. Heart Candles

- A. Explain what Heart Candles are, their history, how it is made, how to inherit it.
- B. Receive a Heart Candle from a church elder.

XVI. Fasting

- A. Explain how and why Unification Church members fast.
- B. Do a one day fast

What Is the God's Heart Program

The God's Heart program is a religious emblem program, created for Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, or Explorers.

To earn the God's Heart emblem, candidates serve others, and learn about our Heavenly Father, True Parents, and the Unification Church. The God's Heart emblem is not just an external accomplishment. To earn it, candidates will move closer to Heavenly Father, and become more mature persons.

The Process of Earning the God's Heart Badge

The process of earning the God's Heart is:

1. Candidates and their parents locate a counselor.
2. The counselor and parents work with the candidate to fulfill the God's Heart requirements.
3. The counselor and parents certify that the candidate has fulfilled the God's Heart requirements.
4. The God's Heart is awarded, usually at a church service.

Who May Be a Counselor

The counselor is someone who is, or is approved by a Unification Church Leader. Any Local, City, State, Regional, or National Unification Church Leader can approve a counselor.

A counselor need not be a Unification Church member, although a counselor must have a clear understanding of Unification Theology and tradition. A counselor should be someone who has the character and knowledge to lead the candidate to a deeper understanding of God, True Parents, and the Unification Church.

What a Counselor Does

The counselor confers the God's Heart award. Externally, the counselor decides what a requirement is, and when a requirement is fulfilled. The counselor may change, add, or replace God's Heart requirements. A counselor may council individual candidates or groups of candidates.

Internally, the counselor should raise and educate the candidate, so that the candidate's understanding of Unificationism deepens, relation with God intensifies, and maturity increases.

When the counselor considers that the candidate has fulfilled the God's Heart requirements, the counselor signs the *God's Heart Completion Form*, which is mailed to the Unification Church Religious Emblem Committee. The Religious Emblem Committee will record the awarding of the God's Heart. The committee will also mail a God's Heart Certificate and (optionally) a God's Heart Medal to be awarded to the candidate.

Usually, the counselor will present the God's Heart award at a church meeting.

God's Heart Requirements

There are two groups of God's Heart requirements, The Heart of God and True Parents requirements and Unification Church requirements. The Heart of God and True Parents requirements are internal and Unification Church requirements are external.

The Heart of God and True Parents requirements are in three stages, the Heart of God, the Value of True Parents, and the Position of Blessed Children. The candidate should understand the heart, attitude, and temperament that Unification Church members try to exemplify.

The purposes of the Heart of God requirements are to insure the candidates understanding of Heavenly Father's heart and how He feels about the human predicament. This understanding is heartistic. It should be shown in all God's Heart requirements.

The purpose of the Value of True Parents requirements is to insure the candidates understanding of the nature, mission, and value of the messiah. This includes grasping how Reverend and Mrs. Moon became True Parents, what their responsibilities are as True Parents, and how the candidate should heartistically relate to them.

The purpose of the Blessed Children requirements is to be sure that each candidate knows what a blessed child is. It is also to show how children who are Unification Church members should serve others.

Unification Church requirements deal with the traditions of the Unification Church. To understand these traditions the candidate should inherit the heart that Reverend and Mrs. Moon have exemplified by their life of sacrificial loving and willingness to pay indemnity for others. The details of external tradition are secondary to inheriting the heart of the tradition.

If you need advice on a Unification Church requirement, contact your Local, City, State, Regional, National, or other Unification Church Leader.

Each candidate keeps a notebook, which is used to fulfill the God's Heart requirements. The God's Heart notebook is a historic record of the candidates' fulfillment of God's Heart requirements. It will be treasured by the candidates' descendants. Externally, the notebook emphasizes the seriousness of the award. As well and internally, having to write things down makes a candidates understanding clearer.

Publications that may help counselor or candidate include: *Outline of the Divine Principle Level IV (in 2015 terms this would be replaced by The Exposition of the Divine Principle)*, *The Tradition Volume 1*, *God's Will and the World*.
