
#### CELEBRATION DATE: SATURDAY JANUARY 25, 2020

On February 10th, 2013, it was renamed as "True Heavenly Parents' Day"

## What is "Heavenly Parent's Day"?

STARTING THE NEW YEAR WITH GOD, OUR HEAVENLY PARENT, AS OUR CENTER BY REDEDICATING OURSELVES TO GOD.

CELEBRATED ON THE 1ST DAY OF THE NEW YEAR, ACCORDING TO THE LUNAR CALENDAR.

"God's Day gives Him the opportunity to show His love to His children."

"What kind of day is God's Day? For God, it is a joyful day and a good day. He wants to encounter good people on this day. He wants to bless you and celebrate this day with you, but actually, He has no one qualified to receive that blessing. All around the world people are celebrating this first day of the year, but only members of the Unification Church celebrate it as God's Day. Therefore, God wants to be with you this day."

"Long in advance, you must begin to prepare for each new God's Day, planning what to offer from the depths of your heart... An offering is not limited to the time in which it is made. It becomes the gift of all things of creation, the gift of the children, and the gift of one's self. Before you come to God's Day, repent of all your ungodliness and sweep it away."

## **SIGNIFICANCE:**

GOD GAVE ADAM & EVE THE "THREE GREAT BLESSINGS" AT THE TIME OF CREATION. HOWEVER, THEY FELL AWAY FROM GOD AND WERE NOT ABLE TO FULFILL THEM. THROUGH THE WORK OF JESUS AND TRUE PARENTS, THE THREE GREAT BLESSINGS HAVE BEEN RESTORED AND BROUGHT US BACK INTO A TRUE RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD, OUR HEAVENLY PARENT, THUS ESTABLISHING TRUE HEAVENLY PARENT'S DAY.

"God blessed Adam and Eve and hoped that they would complete the Three Great blessings (1: to reach individual perfection, 2: to marry, become husband and wife and then build a family by conceiving children, 3: to be the owners of creation and to govern it with love.)

On the day that Adam and Eve got married, it would have been a day of joy not only for the perfection of two children of God, but also for Adam and Eve to stand as a husband and a

wife to each other, and for all creation to welcome their owner of true love. In other words, 'Parents' Day', 'Children's Day', 'Day of All Things', and 'God's Day' were supposed to be on the same day. However, when Adam and Eve fell, all of God's ideal of Creation was lost.

True Parents walked the path to restore God's ideal of creation that was lost. Overcoming various hardships, on April 11th, 1960, True Parents were wed through a Holy Wedding Ceremony. Due to their victory over the seven-year course of restoration, 'God's Day' was declared on January 1st, 1968."

- How do you prepare yourself before celebrating a holy day?
- What does the family pledge mean to you?
- What is the significance of the fruits and beautiful food on the offering table?
- Reflect on the traditions you want to create in your own family. How can you celebrate this
  holy day in your home, church, community?

- Offering Table: Create a offering table together and hold a simple Family Pledge Service
  in your home- or attend a local ceremony
- Cake: Share a cake or favorite treat together as a family. Sing "Happy Heavenly Parent's Day to you!"
- Banner: Create a banner together as a family saying "Happy Heavenly Parent's Day!"
- Gift: To celebrate God & True Parent's love for your child: Give them a specialgift.



## PARENTAL LOVE

FEBRUARY 1, 2019

A lesson celebrating Parental Love- unconditional love that we receive from our parents and ultimately from God our Heavenly Parent. This lesson also celebrates Heavenly Parent's Day & True Parents' Birthday! We're so grateful to True Parents who teach us about the 4 Realms of Heart.













## "Parental Love" Unit: 4 Realms of Heart

LESSON PURPOSE: LEARNING ABOUT OUR PARENTS' HEART AS WELL AS GOD, OUR HEAVENLY PARENT, AND TRUE PARENT'S LOVE FOR US.

MATERIALS: Picture Book, learning toys, craft supplies

BOOKS: God Gave Us You / Kissing Hand / Love You Forever / I Love You
Stinky Face / Guess How Much I Love You

SONG IDEAS: God Loves Me Veggie Tales / I Love You (Barney Theme Song) / What a Wonderful World

AS CHILDREN ARRIVE: Choose 1 Sensory Activity:

- **Dolls:** Baby dollies, diapers, bottles, blankets, stuffed animals.
- Mommy Daddy play centers: kitchen play food, building tools, gardening, car garage
- Playdough: playdough & heart cookie cutters.
- Birthday Sensory bin: filled with streamers, pom poms, party hats, candles, balloons
- Offering Table: have children stack clementines, apples, wrapped cookies, etc.
   Children can holy salt, then stack and pray over it thanking God. And share the snacks later in the lesson.

**SCRIPTURE:** Display the weekly scripture reading, have an older child read it or use it in the lesson as you like.

"See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are." -1 John 3:1

"Grandparents handed down love to parents, the parents handed down love to a husband and a wife, and the couple handed down love to children... You were born of your parents, so your parents were the first ones to whom you could speak. Your first sound was "daddy and mommy." What are parents born for? ## **INTRODUCE the Lesson:**

WELCOME: SONG, PRAYER, TP Greeting

SONG IDEAS: God Loves Me Veggie Tales / I Love You (Barney Theme Song) / What a Wonderful World

#### **REVIEW & TRANSITION:**

We've been learning about the **4 Realms of Heart!** Last week, we celebrated **Valentine's day and how to be a good brother, sister/friend**to others by learning to give and live for others, not just ourselves. As we celebrate Heavenly Parent's Day & True Parents Birthday this month- we are going to**learn about the heart of a Parent!** 

#### **ATTENTION GRABBER:**

- Pregnant Mom or Baby- Show & Tell! If you have a pregnant Momma or a little baby in your congregation- invite them to join you for 5 min! (Or use a photo).

  Discuss with the pregnant mom or parent of the baby about how God blessed Mommy & Daddy with a child to love! Talk about the baby growing inside mommy's belly and how the mommy & Daddy do different things to prepare for baby! What did your parents prepare for youwhen you were a little baby?

  Nursery, diapers, bottles, books, toys etc! Your parents have loved watching you grow in to big boys & girls since then! (Optional: allow children to dress & hold a baby doll or stuffed animal during the lesson)
- **True Parents Family Photo** share a photo of True Parents with all of their children and grandchildren! Ask children who the big family is? Talk about True Parents, their big family and parental love.

#### INTRO:

Your parents want the world for you! Your parents loved you before you were even born!

Parental love is the highest form of love- it is unconditional (loves no matter what!)

like God's love! God, our Heavenly Parent, has a parental heart of love for all of his children! In the same way as True Parents and our own parents do.

#### CHOOSE 1 OR 2: READ A STORY, SING A SONG OR POEM, WATCH A VIDEO:

- VIDEOS: click on the link for educational, sing along or dance videos
  - God Gave Us You Storytime
  - Part of My Heart Read Aloud
  - Family Finger Song Fingerplay sing along
- READ ALOUD STORY:
  - God Gave Us You / Kissing Hand / Love You Forever / I Love You
     Stinky Face / Guess How Much I Love You

#### **SONG OR POEM:**

- Love Is A Circle Love is a circle, Round and round (make a circling motion with arm) Love goes up, (raise arms up) And Love comes down, (lower arms) Love is on the inside, (pull hands inward towards chest) Trying to get out, (pull hands away from chest) Love is whirling and twirling about! (move hands in a spinning motion)
- Family Finger Song Daddy finger, daddy finger, (thumb) where are you? Here I am, here I am How do you do? Mommy finger... (pointer finger) Brother finger... (middle finger) Sister finger... (ring finger) Baby finger... (pinky)

## \*TEACH the Lesson:

#### **TEACHING POINT 1: PARENTAL LOVE**

**TEACHING WITH DISCUSSION:** (Can write answers on a white board, draw pictures of the discussion or sit in a circle taking turns with a talking stick.)

- Read or Watch a Story-Share & discuss any main points from the story.
- DISCUSS: Optional: Visual Family Printable
- What do your Mommy & Daddy do for you because they love you?
  - Cook for me! Make me lunch. Tuck me in, bedtime stories. Daddy plays
     outside with me. Mommy does crafts with me. Drive the car, grocery shop, go
     to work, etc...
- How did your parents prepare for you when you were in your Mama's belly?
  - They sang to your belly, Mama ate healthy & listened to your heart at the doctor, prepared a nursery, bought bottles, diapers, baby books...
- Do you remember being a baby? How did your parents love you then?
  - They rocked me, held me, fed me milk, changed stinky diapers, sang
     lullabies, read stories, played with me...
- What is your favorite way to feel love from Mommy and Daddy now?
   Grandparents? Aunties & Uncles? How do you know they love you?
  - O Hugs, kisses, "I Love You", playing together...
- How does Parental love feel? How does God's love feel?
  - Warm, safe, loving, embracing, sweet, nurturing

TEACHING POINT 2: UNCONDITIONAL LOVEOPTIONAL EXTENSION

Movement Activity- Have children reach out their arms as wide as they can, stretch as high as they can! Hold hands all together and reach as far as they can. Explain that "unconditional" means your parents love you bigger and further and longer than that!

- Use a measuring tape to measure different lengths and talk about how our parents, TP and God, our Heavenly Parent's love can not be measured- it goes on forever!
- Your parents love you so much! They love you when you're happy, excited, try something new, when you're feeling sad, even when you're upset. Your parents will always forgive you for mistakes and love you no matter what. You can always go to your parents for anything. Your parents are so proud of you when you learn new things and receive the greatest joy from watching you grow!

#### **CONCLUSION:**

As we celebrate Heavenly Parents Day & True Parents Birthday, we remember God's love for us as a parent! Just like your parents prepared so much for your arrival as a baby, God prepared this beautiful world for us! In the same way that your parents love you-God loves you! So today we are grateful for our Parents' heart. We give our parents big hugs & blow kisses of gratitude to God, our Heavenly Parent, & True

Parents as we thank them for their love on these special church holy days.

#### **TITHING & PRAYER:**

Dear Heavenly Parent. **Thank you for our Mommy & Daddy**who love us so much! **Thank you for True Parents and for your love God!**We are so grateful. We want to receive all of that warmth, coziness and love to help us grow in to your wonderful children!

## **APPLY the Lesson:**

#### **GROUP ACTIVITIES:** choose 1:

- **TP Birthday Party!** Hold a mini Birthday Party holy day celebration. Sing Happy Birthday to God (to celebrate Heavenly Parent's Day) and to True Parents! (to celebrate their Birthday). Some ideas: make & wear party hats, throw confetti, share a sweet, decorate a cupcake, play a game with balloons. Have children help set up a mini offering table or make a big card or giant cardboard birthday cake together for True Parents. Leftover Valentine's decor & party games work great!
- Valentine's Minute to Win It Games Play fun love, heart themed games together!

CRAFTS: choose 1

Paper Plate Party Hats: pre cut out triangles in the paper plates. Children can
paint with watercolors, decorate with glitter, stickers, pom poms, tissue paper!

Cardboard Birthday Cake: this is a whole group craft- have children all paint & decorate a giant cake together. Present it in the Sanctuary after Service or at your holy day celebration & take a photo of all the children with it! (Pre assemble wrapped boxes)

Invisible Message from God- Write "God Loves \_\_\_\_\_." on each child's paper with a white crayon ahead of time. Have children paint with watercolors- to reveal God's special message! A really cool way to explain gods love. We can't always see it but it's there.

Kissing Hand: Have children put their hand prints on a paper and put a heart sticker in the middle. Explain to parents that they can place a kiss in their child's hand that will go with them everywhere they go and help them feel safe and loved.
 It never washes off! Kissing Hand Coloring Page

 Thank You Cards: Have children draw a picture of their family and write (or teacher writes) what they love about their parents on the card. Card can be in the shape of a heart. Children can color & decorate.

**SPECIAL:** optional

\*BABY PHOTOS: Fun idea for next Sunday! For next Sunday's lesson of "Children's Love" ask parents to bring in a photo of their child as a baby! Then we'll play a baby photo guessing game with all the children. :) Teachers can also participate!

#### **SNACK IDEAS:**

Valentine themed healthy snacks!

## GOD IN OUR HEARTS

JANUARY 1, 2019

Let's start the New Year with God in our hearts! By inviting our Heavenly Parent to live inside of our hearts we can make positive decisions and choices centered on God. Children will learn about 3 things they can do to invite God into their hearts: Talking to God, Learning about God & Experiencing God. (In the optional extension, children will learn about physical & spiritual eyes and that we want to open the eyes of our heart to the light of God and True Parents.) A fun filled lesson with lots of heart activities.













## "God in Our Hearts" Unit: Child of God

**LESSON PURPOSE:** CARRYING GOD IN OUR HEARTS THROUGH OPENING THE EYES OF MY HEART!

MATERIALS: heart cut outs, googly eyes or eye stickers

BOOKS: "God's Love In My Heart" / "Come In to My Heart Lord Jesus" /
"Every Which Way to Pray"

SONG IDEAS: Open the Eyes of My Heart / God Loves Me / I've Got the Joy Joy / God's Love is so Wonderful / See Through Children's Eyes

AS CHILDREN ARRIVE: Choose 1 Sensory Activity:

- Winter Sensory bin: cotton balls, white & blue pom poms, rice, snowflakes...
- Find the Heart Sensory bin: Hide small hearts in a bin of rice.
- Playdough hearts: Have children use cookie cutter hearts and playdough.

**SCRIPTURE:** Display the weekly scripture reading, have an older child read it or use it in the lesson as you like.

"We must open our eyes again and look at God in whom we believe..." - True Father

## **INTRODUCE** the Lesson:

WELCOME: SONG, PRAYER, TP Greeting

SONG IDEAS: Open the Eyes of My Heart / God Loves Me / I've Got the Joy Joy Joy / God's Love is so Wonderful / See Through Children's Eyes

For older kids: Give Me Your Eyes

#### **REVIEW & TRANSITION:**

Last week we learned that **we are perfect together!** God made us each unique and when we work together we can create something very beautiful that brings joy to God &

others! Does anyone know what holiday is coming up soon? **Valentine's Day!** That's right. :) Before we learn all about Valentine's day and love- we want to talk abou**how to have God's love in our hearts first!** 

#### **ATTENTION GRABBER:** choose 1:

Have children put eyes on hearts! (drawing eyes on hearts on a board, googly eyes on heart cut outs, eye stickers on their own heart, pin the tail on the donkey type game...etc) What do eyes do? They help see! (Optional: Sing "I Use My Eyes To See" from previous lesson) We want the eyes of our heart & soul to see God and see good things.

#### INTRO:

Let's slide in to the **New Year with God in our hearts!** But how? Through "Opening the Eyes of our Hearts". (Can show children a heart with googly eyes on it!)

CHOOSE 1 OR 2: READ A STORY, SING A SONG OR POEM, WATCH A VIDEO:

- VIDEOS: click on the link for educational, sing along or dance videos
  - "Open The Eyes of My heart" worship dance song
  - "Love the Lord" worship dance song
- READ ALOUD STORY:
  - "God's Love In My Heart" / "Come In to My Heart Lord Jesus" / "Every
     Which Way to Pray"
- SONG OR POEM:
  - "Hold my hand, God, lead the way. Help me be good every day. Let me know what's wrong and right. Keep me safe all through the night. Let me know what you have planned. Lead the way God, hold my hand."

## \*TEACH the Lesson:

#### TEACHING POINT 1: OPEN THE EYES OF MY HEART

God wants to live inside our hearts- He wants to be a part of our life, love us and help us make good choices. **In order to open our hearts** for God our Heavenly Parent, to dwell and live in us. **We can do 3 things!** Discuss the following. (Can write or draw pictures on a board as you talk. Use the bullet points below or create your own together).

**TALK to God:** You can talk to God about anything! He listens.

Prayer- Prayer is the language of the heart! We can pray in the morning, before
meals, at bedtime. We can even talk to God all day long and invite Him in to all we

do!

• **Song-** Worship God through singing or dance! Listen for his voice in the song lyrics.

#### **LEARN** about God:

- Church- going to Sunday School to learn about how to live a godly life!
- **Scriptures** reading God's Words (hdh, Bible, DP, TPs words...) helps you learn how to guard and protect your heart- to let in goodness and keep out the bad.

#### **EXPERIENCE God:**

- Loving Others- share with your family & friends, serve and help others! Live like

  Jesus and True Parents do and our hearts can grow. Listening to and respecting your

  parents. They love you like God does!
- Nature- experience God's love through all of his Creation. Spend time outside admiring all the different nature & animals!

## TEACHING POINT 2: SPIRITUAL EYES\* OPTIONAL EXTENSION FOR OLDER CHILDREN

#### **DISCUSSION:**

- What can help us make good choices? Opening up the eyes of our heart to God, inviting God to live in our hearts and be a part of our decision making. (vertical alignment)
- How can we help open the eyes of our hearts? Through talking to God,
   learning about God and experiencing God!

• Snowman heart- Have children make snowmen out of paper doilies, cotton balls

• Heart Mobile- Write 1 John 4:16 on a cloud. Have children write their names or

come! What do you think He created next? (Us! People! You + Me!)

#### **ATTENTION GRABBER:** choose 1

- Playdoh Person- Using a ball of playdoh, mold a person. Ask children to guess

- SONG OR POEM:
  - He Made Us! tune of London Bridge- "God wanted to share his love, share his love, share his love. God wanted to share his love, so He made us! He made us in His image, His image, His image. He made us in His image, boys and girls. He asked us to be caretakers, be caretakers, be caretakers. He asked us to be caretakers, of all Creation. Everything that God had made, God had made. Everything that God had made- was very good!"

## \*TEACH the Lesson:

#### **TEACHING WITH DISCUSSION:**

After God had finished creating the beautiful world, something was missing. He wanted someone to share His love with, someone to give this beautiful World to as a gift. God created people! God our Heavenly Parent said: "Let us make mankind in our image". God took some dust from the ground and He breathed a breath of life into the dust- this made the first man Adam. God saw that Adam needed a friend so he caused Adam to fall into a deep sleep. While he was sleeping, God made a woman out of one of Adam's ribs and called her Eve. He placed them in the most beautiful garden- the Garden of Eden and said "It is very good". He asked Adam + Eve to grow in God's love, have a beautiful family and to take good care of Creation.

#### Discussion:

- Why did God make people? To share his love with them. To share this beautiful
  world with them
- How did God make Adam? Out of dust.
- How did God make Eve? Out of one of Adam's ribs.

#### TEACHING POINT 2: WHAT MAKES US SPECIAL? OPTIONAL EXTENSION

God made people different (from the animals). He breathed the breath of life into us. This means God gave us a spirit. God dwells within us, and lives in our hearts. He created us in His image, in his likeness- male and female. Everything about us- is a reflection of God, our Heavenly Parent. Everything about us is perfectly crafted and unique. We each have our own body, personality, style, talents and hobbies. God also made us co-creators- we can create just like God can! Can animals paint pictures, make buildings or sing songs? No- only we can be creative just like God! This makes us super special. We are God's special children whom He loves very much.

#### **Discussion:**

- What makes people different from animals + nature?
  - We have God's Spirit- the breath of life in us!
  - We are created in God's image- male + female. We are a reflection of God, our Heavenly Parent.

 We can create- like God. We can be artists, scientists, explorers, teachers, helpers... (Animals can't do that) This makes us special.

We are God's children.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

Today we learned that when God made the World, his most precious creation was us!

God's very first children were Adam + Eve. God loves us, his children, so much. He gave us the breath of life, created us in His image and made us each unique with special talents.

#### **TITHING & PRAYER:**

Dear Heavenly Parent, thank you for making Adam + Eve! Thank you for making us special and in your image. We are so grateful to be your children and to be loved by you. We will do our best to grow, love others and take care of the beautiful world you gave us. Amen. Aju!

- Paper Plate Face- Have children make their face + hair on a paper plate using stickers, buttons, yarn, markers. Post them on a bulletin board.
- Around the World Bulletin Board- Make an Earth. Have each child color +

decorate a person. Glue the people around the world.

Children of the World- Print the coloring page.





# Parents around the world universally desire for their children to be happy,

healthy, confident and able to make good choices which lead to success in all areas of their lives. From the moment we look into the eyes of our newborn babies, we know deep down that this is our greatest responsibility, whether we feel confident to do so or not. As our children grow we do our best to keep them safe, well-



nourished, stimulated and loved; physically, intellectually and emotionally.

Additionally, and possibly most importantly, parents have the privilege to guide our children to knowing who their Heavenly Parent is, to nurture a sense of belonging, secure attachment and confidence in their relationship with God, that God is theirs and that they hold a unique place in God's heart. This will look different for every family and depends on many factors such as how much the children already innately feel a connection to God, how deep our own relationship and that of our spouse is with God, what traditions our families value and keep in our lives of faith. Wherever we feel we are currently in our journey of faith, exploring our relationships with God and each other will most likely bring up a myriad of thoughts and feelings in us. This is not surprising as what we think about God and what our relationship with our Heavenly Parent looks like informs our views on everything that is truly important in our lives; our identity, relationships with others, what we believe the purpose of life is, our understanding of morality, and where we choose to place our focus and invest our time and efforts. You could say that our family culture depends on what our relationship with God is like.



Thinking back on our own lives, we may have been raised in a family who loved and served God and yet there were challenges which caused our relationship with God to suffer. Some may be at the very beginning of getting to know God and building a relationship with our Creator, while others feel relatively uninhibited to share the love they have for God with their children. Parenting our

own children bring the most important topics into focus as we navigate the ups and downs of life, needing to respond to difficult situations and tough questions every child will inevitably ask.

As our children enter adolescence, it becomes particularly important for them to see authenticity and integrity in adults around them. Our growing relationship with God serves as an inspiration to our children, to see us humbled, challenged and strengthened, loved and fulfilled by the ultimate source of unconditional love. Our children yearn to see what fulfilled human potential looks like and to see adults around them genuinely striving to be their best selves can only serve as an example to them.

How then do we guide our children in their spiritual growth, in knowing our Heavenly Parent and in giving and receiving love with God? The answer, of course, is in first investing in our own growth in this area, in nourishing our own spirituality, our connection with the Divine within us and without. As we do this we will be in a much better position to love ourselves, our spouse and children the way God does and wants us to. Our



growth and development is a living testimony to the awesome love of our Creator and connects us to each other in bonds of true love. Having a living and breathing relationship with God sharpens our conscience and awareness of what is right and what is wrong, even and especially when situations are ambiguous.

In parenting our children we face making many decisions for our children, then gradually include them and finally trust them to make decisions for themselves. We model

an authentic life of faith to our children and guide them to discover their own, unique way of relating with their Heavenly Parent. As they grow, we encourage them to create healthy habits that will build their life of faith, such as talking naturally and frequently with God, studying His Word, reflecting on their life and setting goals which help them to live with more purpose.



Knowing and feeling God's viewpoint and heart places us and our children in a stronger, more confident position to make difficult decisions, especially when those decisions are counter-cultural. No matter what the situation, with our hearts and minds in tune with God's, we can surmount any challenge and not lose ourselves along the way. Most importantly, we fulfill the very purpose for

which the entire Universe exists - so that God can hold us as his dearest creation and we find our deepest meaning and joy in sharing in a personal relationship with our Heavenly Parent.


