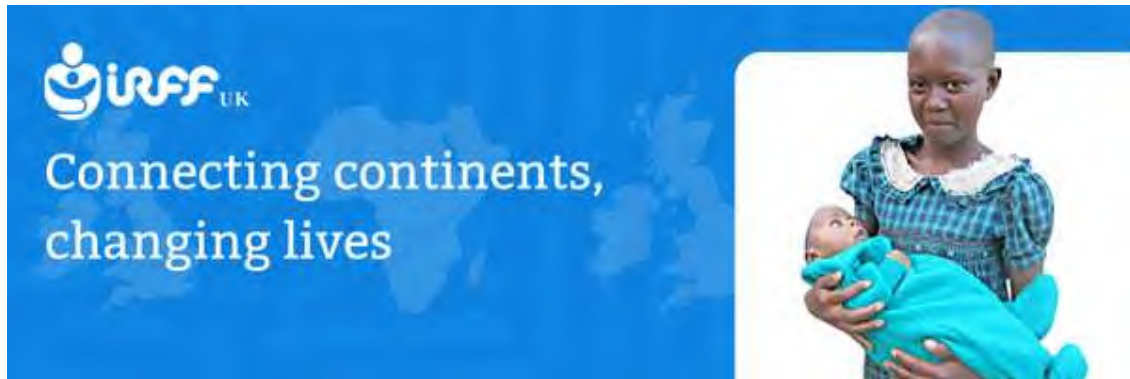

Charity magic awakens communities

This month, we reflect on something central to IRFF UK – **the role of individuals who take initiative**. This is the heart of our work. Much of it starts with **simple ideas that are carried through by supporters with a clear purpose**.

Bringing people together in London

Last month in London, supporters organised the venue and logistics for a magic and mind-reading show led by illusionist Simon Rosselli, with support from singer-songwriter Peter Graham. **Every ticket sold and every raffle entry** helped support IRFF's Destiny Junior School in Uganda, contributing to safe education and daily meals for children who depend on it.



This event was powered by volunteers, performers, local businesses, and attendees, all playing a part, and it received coverage in local media. But what made it especially meaningful was that, for a few hours, **a community in London connected with a classroom in Uganda.**

One volunteer later said, “*What stayed with me was **how many people stepped up to help.***”

A charity concert in Madrid

In March, **a different kind of initiative took place in Madrid.** As part of the *Festival of Hope for Peace*, a charity concert was organised by Mercedes Gonzales to support IRFF UK’s work. The programme featured performances from the Coro Alborada choir and singer-songwriter Alejandro Travi Lozano, alongside talks, recognition awards, and a presentation on IRFF UK’s work.



Through images and stories, guests were introduced to Destiny School, outlining **the progress achieved and the ongoing challenges faced by the children there.**

One Message, Two Locations

London and Madrid were different events, but they shared one thing in common: **they began with a decision by individuals who recognised a need and then took initiative.**

This kind of action sustains IRFF UK's work. It empowers us and **drives our charity forward.** Thank you to each of you who supports us!

IRFF UK built Destiny Junior School in 2009. The children in the local area have thrived ever since!

IRFF UK built **Destiny Junior School** in Kampala, Uganda in 2009, and has gone on to see more than 500 students graduates go into further education which otherwise wouldn't have happened. £115,000 has been invested in total, starting from £330 a month and now at £1,150 with 206 students in total
