Dear family,

We know many people are awaiting information on when the upcoming grace ceremonies will be held in our community and other information. We have scheduled two dates. As of now, these ceremonies can only be officiated at the church, in person, so we hope everyone can make one of these dates. It is possible we may be able to make exceptions, just like in the previous ceremony a couple years ago, but there is no word on that yet. Our dates will be:

Saturday, March 8 @ 2pm Sunday, March 16 @ 1pm

Please register online (button at the end of the email) and make sure to read through the requirements.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE: We have received somewhat conflicting information about who should receive the grace ceremony. Until that is worked out, this is the basic information. According to the Blessed Family Ministry, this ceremony is for Blessed Couples and Blessed Children. In addition, those getting ready to receive the Blessing in April should not receive the grace ceremony, here because they will receive it at the Blessing. This is fundamentally the same as the grace ceremony two years ago. However, HSA leadership has stated that everyone should receive it, but they must follow all the requirements set out below.

Our community will follow the guidelines from the Blessed Family Ministry, since the Grace Ceremony is focused around the Blessing, which is their domain of expertise. However, we will not turn anyone away that wishes to participate that has completed all the requirements.

There is no need to let us know if you are not planning to participate.

The following is an explanation from Rev. Thompson about the special grace.

As you may know, we are currently in a 70-Day Special Grace period, which began on Sunday, February 2, and will continue until April 12. Our beloved True Mother is establishing the necessary conditions to offer this Special Grace to all of us before the Entrance Ceremony to Cheon Won Gung Cheon II Sanctum. Through her love, tears, and devotion, she is making it possible for all of Heavenly Parent's children to fully rejoice, participate, and enter this new era free from the burdens of the past.

This Special Grace is an opportunity to cleanse personal and familial violations of Heavenly law, whether committed consciously or unconsciously. It allows for healing in ethical, spiritual, and relational matters, restoring individuals as true citizens of Cheon II Guk. Every person, family, and community is invited to receive this Special Grace and join in building Heaven within their homes and society.

The Special Grace is for everyone, therefore we encourage all families and members; (1st Gen, 2nd Gen, 3rd Gen, Intergeneration couples, etc) in the West and across the nation to participate.

- 1. At least one week of intentional devotion as determined by each family, including Hoon Dok Hae, reflection, prayer, bowing.
- 2. Participation at least one time in a Cheon Shim Won Night Prayer Vigil (in person or online) during the one-week devotion period. Some communities offer night vigils locally.



- 5. Completion of a financial donation of gratitude based on the number 13 from each participating family or member. Use this form to make the donation.


