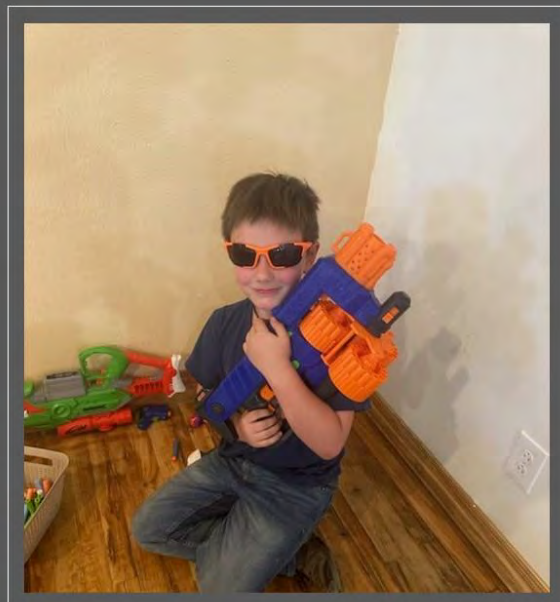
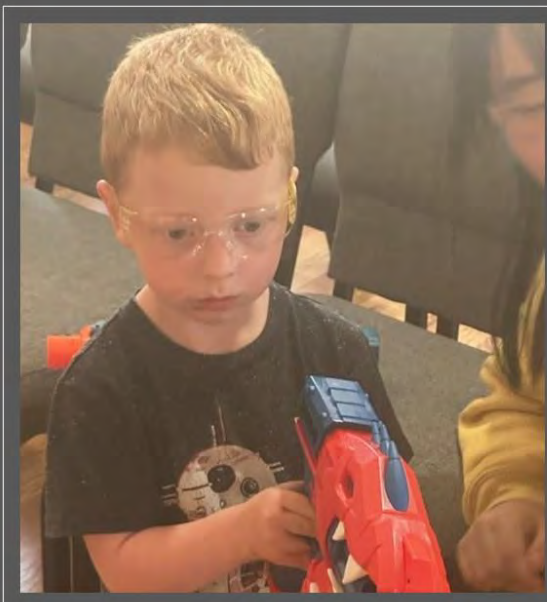

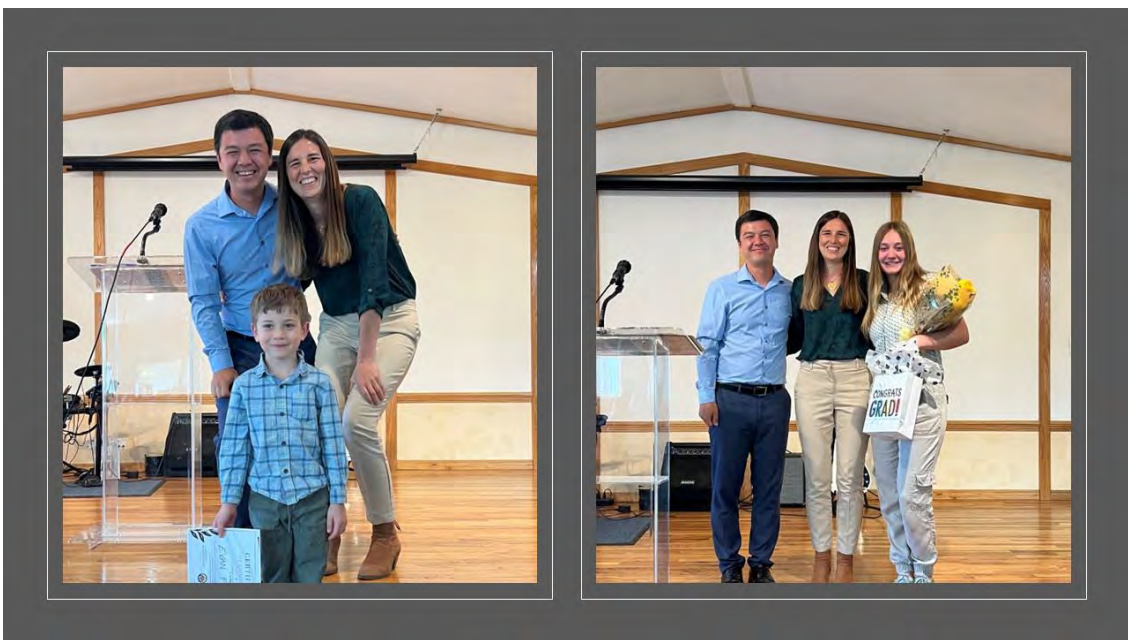






Sunday School Graduation
