Pastor Franklin asked for each speaker to be free to speak at length in order to encourage them to be open but that turned out to be too generous as each one wanted to give a half hour talk without notes! So, in the end, it was limited to 15 minutes each.



It is remarkable how sincere and full of passion these young people are. They faced themselves in this past year and found that they could work together in teams, develop deep bonds of friendship and receive guidance followed by experience in a life of faith. Their confidence in themselves and the knowledge that they had found their own relationship to God was evident.

We were fortunate that not only did we hear from South London Second Gens but also from those of other countries who were still in the region after attending the Senior HARP Workshop as staff in Cleeve House.
