

Recruitment of a Pastor for the Scottish Community

The FFWPU UK headquarters along with the Scottish community is recruiting a Pastor for Scotland to be resident in Scotland. The Pastor's main goal would be to raise the next generation of young leaders who could positively impact society by empowering them through the study and application of Unification Principles.

Applicants from the UK or even from abroad would be most welcome.

Job Description

The Pastor will primarily lead the FFWPU Scottish Community, which includes 2nd generation and 3rd generation Unificationists – and coordinate the growth of the community through educational and evangelical activities. This will involve:

- Organising workshops that teach Divine Principle and raise leadership skills
- Empowering local communities to cultivate relationships amongst student and young adult members
- Maintaining a Sunday Service schedule
- Coordinating local and broader evangelical programmes
- Coordinating student-focused worship services in the local communities (developing CARP)
- Overseeing UPF programmes
- Co-ordinating and developing existing relationships with other organisations – eg the interfaith council of Scotland
- Ensuring that high standards are maintained with overseeing branches of government – eg the charities board of Scotland as FFWPU is a registered charity in Scotland
- Building a team of volunteers to support with the above tasks
- Attending regular meetings with the National board of FFWPU based in London

Qualifications

- Right to work in the UK (essential)
- Exemplary standard of faith and character (essential)
- Good communication in English language, spoken and written (essential)
- Management skills; ability to work with a team (essential)
- Experience of teaching Divine Principle and speaking in public (preferable)

Details

The Pastor's term of employment would be a three-year contract, renewable at the end of the contract in 2020. The Pastor's line manager will be the National Director of FFWPU-UK.

There is a modest financial package available to be discussed at the time of interview.
