Programme:

On Saturday afternoon the HTM Directors for the Europe and Middle East Region, Dr David and Mrs Patricia Earle, will lead us through two presentations and working sessions. (They recently delivered similar content in a meeting in Seebenstein, Austria and it was very well received.)

In the evening we will have a session where we can offer our sincere devotion; singing and praying together.

On Sunday, after Hoon Dok Hae and breakfast, Dr Michael Balcomb, our EUME Group Chair, will share important new insights and practical guidance – within the theme and spirit of 'Making it Possible'.

Our national leader, Matthew Huish, together with David and Kyung-Ja Hanna will be helping. Chef

Who is it for?

Any FFWPU members are welcome to attend (Second Generation members as well as First).

If you have not made the HTM Resolution offered at the end of August, but would like to do so (with the benefit of the help and explanation that this programme will provide), there will be a short ceremony at the end where you can do that. Our resolve is the first step!

Accommodation

There is space for around 40 people in Livingstone House to stay over on Saturday night (single-sex dorms with mattresses on the floor as well as a number of rooms with two beds). If you live within easy travelling distance, commuting is fine. It is also fine if you want to make your own arrangements to stay in the area, BUT WE NEED TO KNOW – so everyone who wishes to attend is asked to complete and return this online registration form:

Fee

The workshop fee is per person and can be calculated by summing the individual components:

Daily attendance rate (includes two meals) £15

Overnight stay (single-sex dorm, mattress on floor)* £20 Overnight stay (bed – two or three in a room) £25

* £5 reduction if you use your own sleeping bag

If there are not enough beds available, we will secure the option of a local hotel (like a Premier Inn). We would have to charge whatever that room rate is, but will arrange transport for you.

Worked examples:

One person attending the Saturday and Sunday, non-residential: £30

A couple staying the weekend in a Livingstone House room: £110

Ground Transportation

Livingstone House is accessible by train to Elmstead Woods (Charing Cross line). Bromley South (Victoria line) is also a possibility, but is further away.

A number of buses stop on or near Chislehurst High Street.
