Original Substance of the Divine Principle to Educate 5,000 Faith Leaders through National Broadcast - Michael Jenkins

For the first time, the Unificationist commentary on the Bible, known as the Original Substance of the Divine Principle (OSDP), will be broadcast nationwide, and thousands of American clergy are expected to participate.

The broadcast on Saturday, Dec. 1, 2012 to 100 locations in the United States offers a three-hour seminar, originating at the Manhattan Center for the Performing Arts in New York City and will be taught by three respected clergy associated with the American Clergy Leadership Conference (ACLC). Lecturers include Archbishop George Augustus Stallings, Jr., founder of the Imani Temple in Washington, D.C., Bishop Jesse Edwards of Philadelphia, and Rev. Patra Kidwell, founder of God's Ministry Church in Capitol Heights, Maryland. A second broadcast is planned for Saturday, Dec. 15, 2012.

Under the direction of the late Rev. Sun Myung Moon, known by Unificationists as "Father Moon" or "True Father," Unificationist ministers made a goal to reach out to 13,000 faith leaders by February 22, 2013. Through the unified efforts of Unificationists, a total of 8,000 faith leaders have already been educated – 62 percent of Father Moon's pronounced goal before he passed away Sept. 3, 2012.

"Father Moon spent nine years in prayer and study after he met Jesus," wrote Dr. Michael Jenkins to Unificationnews.com. "This OSDP teaching is the essence of the revelation Father Moon received and is the basis for building families based on true love and opening the door for the coming Kingdom of God. His final work with Christianity was to lift up 172 pastors and to ask that we [Unificationists and faith leaders] multiply to 13,000. We will realize that cherished goal through these historic broadcasts."

Both Saturday broadcast programs on December 1, 2012 and December 15, 2012lasts from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM (EST).

The OSDP content has been condensed to a three-hour format for these programs. Presentations will be delivered by skilled American Clergy Leadership Conference (ACLC) clergy. The broadcasts, which can be accessed online by local churches, community centers, as well as international Unification Church facilities, will be recorded for use in future programs.

A scheduled speaker for the December 1st program, Archbishop George Augusts Stallings Jr., wrote to Unificationnews.com that, "My ministry, especially my preaching and teaching, has been strengthened and renewed as a result of the revelatory content contained in the study of the OSDP." He added that he highly recommends the OSDP workshop to any pastor or minister who desires to be spiritually renewed and biblically- and theologically enriched.

In order to reach thousands of new participants, the Unification Church headquarters has asked each of the 12 district headquarters' offices to educate at least 120 people in each broadcast. The remaining 38 state churches have made a goal of involving at least 30 people in each broadcast. This can be achieved by including all district satellite locations in the broadcast. Participants will include faith leaders, members of the Universal Peace Federation known as Ambassadors for Peace, witnessing contacts and

Unificationists.

A participation fee of \$10.00 per person is requested for each broadcast. The revenue will be shared by the District locations (60 percent) and the Unification Church Headquarters (40 percent) to cover program costs.

"I really look forward to having Divine Principle education in this church through a national broadcast this Saturday," said Rev. Gary Chidester, new District Pastor of District 5 [Georgia, South Carolina, Florida, Alabama, Louisiana, and Mississippi]. "We have organized prayer breakfasts, but we never had this kind of education before. Several ministers who are part of the 172 ministers who traveled to Korea last year to be with Father Moon will be attending the broadcast in Fort Lauderdale, Florida."
