Youth Federation for World Peace Inaugural Conference (July 26, 1994, Washington D.C.)

Only July 26, 1994, the inaugural conference for the Youth Federation for World Peace took place at the Omni Shoreham Hotel in Washington D.C., in the United States. Representatives from 163 nations attended this conference, which was held with an aim to build a community of true peace, which goes beyond ideologies of left and right. True Father said, "As fruits of a new family and new school education, the youth need to become people who instruct and take responsibility in their families and societies." The Youth Federation for World Peace was registered as a social organization in Korea on February 22, 1995, and is actively developing its activities.

124-Couple Blessing Ceremony (July 24, 1963, Seoul, Korea)

The 124-Couple Blessing Ceremony took place on July 24, 1963, in Seoul's Citizens' Hall. Around 3,500 guests partook in the event. This was the first time the Blessing Ceremony was held in a public building, and it attracted a lot of attention from Korean citizens. True Father said, "The president of this nation cannot achieve this. This is something only the Unification Church can do." After the Blessing Ceremony, the brides and grooms rode in 150 separate 'New Country Cars,' paraded around the city with police vehicles guiding the parade.
