Memo regarding Prayer Ending for Blessed Families

Below is a memo from International HQ regarding prayer endings for Blessed Families.

May the blessings and love of Heavenly Parent and True Parents always accompany you. In accordance with True Parents' instructions, the era of praying in the name of our "blessed central family" began in 1999. From 2001, prayers were transformed into "reports" to God, and from 2006 we started concluding our prayers with "Aju."

Since then, many more people are praying in their own names as individuals, in the name of a husband and wife, or in their family's name, yet

no further guidelines were given over the years. Now, however, True Mother has made a clear request to us that we end our prayers in our individual name only.

Accordingly, this memo is to clarify our prayer ending. We ask that leaders, blessed families, and members at the regional headquarters familiarize themselves with this information and provide guidance so that prayers can be concluded according to the following guidelines:

1. Blessed Family Member's Prayer Closing

A. "I pray (or report) in the name of [name of the one praying] of a blessed central family. Aju"

2. Related Matters

A. Blessed children who have not yet received the Blessing are asked to pray "in the name of [name of the one praying], a 2nd (3rd, 4th) generation blessed child. Aju." For single 1st generation members, please pray in the name of True Parents. B. Questions can be sent to the IHQ Blessed Family Department via ffwpuihqbfd@ gmail,com.

Next Blessing Date: April 24, 2024

Below is a letter from our Blessed Family Ministry Directors.

The 2024 Hyojeong Cosmic Blessing Festival, which will be held in Korea on April 24, will be a Blessing for both 1st and 2nd generation matched couples, as well as couples who are previously married and older singles, who are qualified to receive a Single Blessing.

For those who would like to attend this Blessing, we would request you to sign up on the BFM website at <u>this</u> link, as soon as possible. For those who sign up, we will be having our first information session on Thursday, March 7th, at 5:00 PM (PST). A Zoom link will be sent to you before the meeting.

The application deadline will be on March 31st, which means you need to complete the following steps by then.

1. SINGLES:

a. Subscribe to <u>MatchNet</u>.

b. Submit Part 1 of the application, which will require you to upload the signed page of the Blessing Interview, the Verification of Identity form, the Health form, and Level 2 certificate..

c. Fill out the Matching Report Form and submit Part 2 of the application.d. Complete the Level 3 online education and submit Part 3 of the application e. Pay the Blessing Offering

2. PREVIOUSLY MARRIED COUPLES:

a. One person in the couple registers on the <u>BFM Education Site</u>.

b. Fill out, and when ready, submit the <u>Blessing Ceremony Application</u>. You will need to download and fill out a Married Couple Blessing Interview form and have an interview. There is a list of interviewers on the page.

c. After your interview is complete, upload the last page of the document to your application, as well as a copy of your marriage certificate.

d. Pay the Blessing Offering.

The international accommodation for couples and guests will host you from April 24 to April 27th. This will be free for the couples and will cost \$300 for guests. For those coming earlier and remaining after, it will be your own responsibility to find accommodation for before and after the Blessing Festival.

HOWEVER, for the couples, I would like to request that you do NOT buy your plane ticket yet, as the American church is planning a special youth workshop after the Blessing in Korea, which will be an amazing opportunity to complete your Blessing experience! More information will be coming as soon as possible so that you can book your flights in a timely manner. Sorry for the little delay!


Testimonies given during victory Sunday should be 2-5 minutes long. Come energized and let's set this community on fire for the kingdom of God.


