Anyonghaseyo, dear brothers and sisters!

Here again some inspiration, based on the words of True Father:

True Father: "To fulfill the human portion of responsibility, we must go beyond the realm of indirect dominion and reach the realm of God's direct dominion. We have to enter that realm where God's heart and our heart become one in God's love; then we can travel freely between the two worlds, heaven and earth. This is the viewpoint of the Principle. Once we secure a horizontal position that can represent the vertical Parent centered on God's love, from that point on, Satan will no longer exist. That is the realm of God's direct dominion." [1]

The more we grow and advance in heart and love, the more we come into the "direct dominion". The realm of direct dominion is only about love, not about God throwing commands at us.

It simply means that we develop God's heart in ourselves and thus become able to love the way God does. We will then treat everyone the way God would treat them, will see everyone and everything with God's eyes. People who see us, will see God in us.

In that stage we automatically act in line with God's heart, because God's heart is our heart. That does not mean that we lose our uniqueness. That does not mean that we all will have the same opinion and taste. Certainly not. But we will all be a unique expression of perfect love, the love of God.

The more we move into this direction, the more all evil in this world will disappear. Evil has no chance to stop divine love. Rather divine love will overcome all evil. True love will be anytime anywhere, forever. That and certainly nothing less is the ideal world of God's design.

Establishing the ideal world is not just the work of the True Parents. We all are called to be involved in spreading divine love everywhere we go:

True Father: "When we understand the mission of the Messiah as a mission of True Parents to realize

God's love in this world, we understand that we too are called by God to pursue and accomplish this mission. The mission of the Messiah is thus the cosmic mission that all men and women of faith ought to undertake." [2]

God's will in this world can only be realized if we are ready and willing to love and embrace even the enemy:

True Father: "The realization of the ideal nation of God begins with individuals determined to love their enemies. The way to win over enemies is not through superior strength. It is possible only through the power of true love, by which we can embrace them... If a nation arises consisting of people who have a mind to love their enemies, it could become the ideal land that God desires." [3]

True Father: "In spite of my many efforts, Americans, including many Christians, misunderstood me, persecuted me and eventually even imprisoned me. The negative attitudes and vicious slander against me continued unabated. Yet, I refused to be caught in negative feelings of hatred or resentment, and I continued to live a life of love, giving consistently to those who persecuted me." [3]

To love in such a way is certainly not only the task of the True Parents or Jesus. We are all requested to become people of such love. Then we are in the realm of direct dominion, and Satan, evil and conflicts of all sorts will come to an end. The bright light of true love will push all evil away. Blessed are those that are in the forefront of the true love revolution!

True Father: "We must restore this nation by love. Even though other Christians have treated us as their enemies, we must love them more than anyone ever has. Eventually that love will win out. " [4]
