
True Father: In true love there is no concept of struggle

Anyonghaseyo, dear brothers and sisters!

Here again some inspiration, based on the words of True Father and Heung Jin Nim:

True Father: "In true love, there is no concept of struggle, only the heart of compassion. In true love, there is only the heart of the parent who gives continuously and then wants to give even more." [1]

The love of God is true love, true parental love. Such love is unchanging, eternal and unconditional. It is a love of endless giving and investing, and then forgetting what was given.

That love is embracing all people, good or bad, saints and tyrants, past and present. It has compassion for everyone. It wants to bless and uplift everyone. In that love there is certainly no resentment against anyone, let alone feelings of revenge. Such love does not struggle with other people, but loves and embraces them instead.

We are requested to inherit this very heart of God. That means we have to develop it in ourselves. We have to bring our own heart to that level. That is our goal, our destination, our blessing. And we have the potential.

This means we have to advance to levels that we have never experienced before. Those who are on this path are on the most precious pioneering path:

True Father: "To pioneer heavenly heart is the path of those who walk the path of paths." [2]

True Father, True Mother and Jesus have already been victorious in the realm of heart. We stand on this foundation of heart. But still we have to walk our own pioneering path, which is unique for everyone. We all have to move forward to conquer all the frontiers in our heart. Otherwise we cannot inherit God's heart. Otherwise we are stuck, stagnating, no matter what great things we might do otherwise. Stagnating in heart, however, should never happen:

True Father: "No matter how long it takes and how stormy the environment, we cannot allow our inner selves to be invaded. We must continue a course of steady development." [3]

We must develop our inner selves, which means we must develop our heart, constantly. How to do it? We must focus on it, and turn every encounter with any person into a victory of love. "Any person" here includes also those that are rejecting or hating us. If they change or not, is not relevant in this context. The question is if we can learn to embrace them with our heart, no matter what. Then we have achieved a mighty victory of heart. That is relevant indeed.

If we focus on making victories of heart in any encounter with people, we will be much more likely to solve problems, based on God's support for such a life. God's support will show up in many ways.

And the giants from the spiritual world, True Father, Heung Jin Nim and Jesus, are always ready to guide us on that path, but only if we ask them:

Heung Jin Nim: "I know how you pray to be able to understand love, how you've been praying to understand the heart of True Parents and yet you always seem to be up against a wall, a dead end. You can't break through... But now I am here and help you in that area. I am here and as you open up your heart, even open up your eyes to me then I can be able to speak to you deeply and as I speak to you deeply you can be transformed. And as you can be transformed.... you will be able to realize deeper and deeper levels of love and you will be able to understand True Parents as a true son and as true daughter." [4]

Finally we will become True Parents ourselves.

By asking those giants in spirit world for education of heart, our hearts will be transformed. We can advance much faster then by trying to do it all by ourselves. It will save us much time and unnecessary struggles.
