## Korea Sends Young Missionaries to Russia

The Cheon Bok Gung Church in Seoul sent out six young missionaries for a 12-day exploratory visit to one of the Vision 2020 sisterhood nations – Russia, according to the Tongil website. The young adults' mission started on August 6, 2013 and will finish on August 18, 2013.
