

UPF UK: A Season of Reflection, Service, and Shared Responsibility

Week 9 of the [Universal Peace Federation's](#) (UPF) [100 Days of Harmony and Hope campaign](#) (19 - 25 December) invites reflection on human solidarity, ethical responsibility, and shared humanity during the holiday season. This week coincides with [United Nations International Human Solidarity Day \(20 December\)](#) and the celebration of Christmas (25 December) - a period that resonates deeply across cultures, faiths, and communities.

The week also highlights two major UN frameworks shaping global cooperation today:
the [UN Decade of Healthy Ageing \(2021 - 2030\)](#), and
the Decade of Action to deliver the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Together, these frameworks call for renewed commitment from governments, civil society, faith communities, and international organisations to accelerate progress towards dignity, inclusion, and sustainable peace by 2030.

UPF's Peacebuilding Vision: Ethics in Action

UPF aligns its peacebuilding and development work with the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, connecting ethical principles with practical cooperation. Founded by [Dr Hak Ja Han](#) and [Dr Sun Myung Moon](#), UPF advances a vision of peace rooted in universal values, strong families, and responsible citizenship.

The founders consistently emphasised that lasting peace begins with human relationships - within families, communities, and societies. As they often noted, peace does not emerge from institutions alone, but from individuals who live for the benefit of others. This guiding principle of human [interdependence, mutual prosperity and universal values](#), continues to shape UPF's approach to service, dialogue, and partnership across nations and cultures.

Christmas, Interfaith Values, and the Culture of Peace

Christmas marks the culmination of Week 9 and is observed by Christians worldwide while also serving as a widely shared cultural moment emphasising generosity, reconciliation, and care for others. UPF approaches this season from an inclusive, interfaith perspective, consistent with [United Nations efforts to promote interreligious dialogue](#) within the Culture of Peace framework and the UN Plan of Action to Prevent Violent Extremism.

Across many countries, UPF chapters use this period to organise community outreach, humanitarian assistance, and interfaith gatherings, demonstrating how shared moral values can strengthen social cohesion and mutual understanding.

Historical Milestones in Late December

Late December holds special historical significance in the work of UPF's founders:

In 1974, the Day of Hope 8-City Speaking Tour began with the landmark address "The New Future of

Christianity" at Madison Square Garden, New York, setting a tone of hope, ethical renewal, and social responsibility. The tour concluded on 23 December 1974, just before Christmas.

In 1992, Dr Hak Ja Han concluded her world speaking tour on 23 December, marking the international launch of the Women's Federation for World Peace, with engagements across Europe, Asia, and Oceania.

In 2005, the founders completed the 120-Nation Global Speaking Tour (16 October - 23 December) [launching the Universal Peace Federation](#), uniting political, academic, religious, and civil society leaders around a shared commitment to peace, ethical leadership, and international cooperation.

Civil Society, NGOs, and Grassroots Solidarity

During this week, UPF recognises the vital contribution of non-governmental organisations that strengthen solidarity at the community level. These include humanitarian organisations such as Caritas Internationalis, Islamic Relief Worldwide, and World Vision, which provide direct support to vulnerable families during the holiday season.

UPF also acknowledges the work of interfaith and peace-oriented networks - including Religions for Peace, the United Religions Initiative, and national interfaith councils - that promote dialogue and cooperation across religious and cultural boundaries. Volunteer-based movements such as Habitat for Humanity further demonstrate how local action contributes to the goals of the 2030 Agenda, translating shared values into practical service.

From Reflection to Renewal

As Week 9 draws to a close, it marks a transition toward the New Year, aligning with new annual cycles for international institutions and multilateral processes. This makes the theme of solidarity especially timely as global priorities are reassessed and renewed.

The Universal Peace Federation UK encourages its [Ambassadors for Peace](#), partners, and supporters to use this season to strengthen cooperation, support inclusive initiatives, and contribute to shared goals for peace and sustainable development. Through service, dialogue, and ethical leadership, the vision of One Family under God can be expressed in civic, social, and global life.

ABOUT THE MOTHER OF PEACE



From a very young age, Mother Moon developed a deep relationship with God in a close father-daughter bond. When she married the late Rev. Sun Myung Moon in 1960, their mutual desire to see a true world of peace led her to join him on a pioneering course as the Mother of Peace.

As the Parents of Peace, Father and Mother Moon presented models for bridging conflict, division, and resentment in the fields of education, politics, arts, sciences, media and human rights, all united under the banner of the Unification movement.

Over her 50 years of public ministry, Mother Moon has dedicated her life to the realization of peace. Acting in the role of humanity's parents, she and her husband created non-profit organizations, businesses, conferences and awards spanning every facet of society and culture to support resolving historical wounds and finding solutions to the world's many problems. At the root of all their initiatives is a path to strengthen families and prevent the breakdown of society through the Marriage Blessing movement.

As the only female religious leader operating on such a global level, her powerful message has inspired millions to transcend national, racial and ideological boundaries.

The Marriage Blessing – Building Peace Through Family

Together with her late husband, Rev. Sun Myung Moon, Dr. Hak Ja Han established the Marriage Blessing movement to transcend barriers of race, religion, and nation as "one family under God."



The cornerstone of her legacy is the Marriage Blessing, which transcends race, culture, nationality, denomination and ideology

Since the first Marriage Blessing officiated by Father and Mother Moon in 1960, this tradition has expanded to become an interreligious affirmation of the universal importance of marriage and family. The Marriage Blessing transcends boundaries and religious affiliations, and creates a shared experience as one family under God.

Mother Moon teaches that women, as true daughters of God, must play a central role in creating a just and peaceful society. She established the Women's Federation for World Peace in 1992, championing the vital role of women in peace building at the United Nations, the United States Capitol, the Great Hall of the People in China and the Korean National Assembly.

We must think of all the world's problems as our own and have the pioneering spirit needed to resolve them.




PEACE IN MATERNAL LOVE
