

## WFWP Hawai'i Chapter Meet and Greet President Kaeleigh Moffitt Potluck Dinner

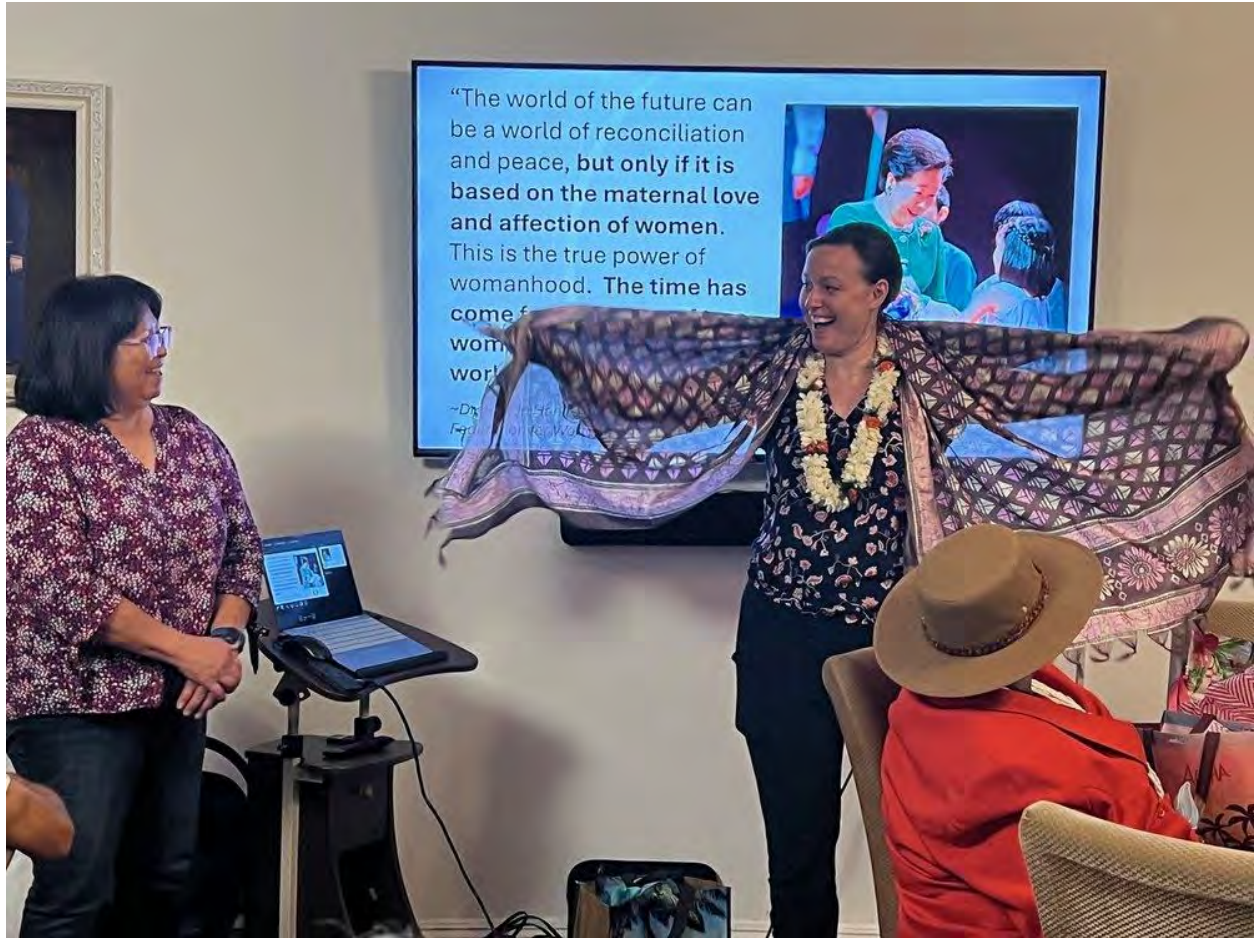

continued growth and collaboration, leaving an indelible mark on all who attended.



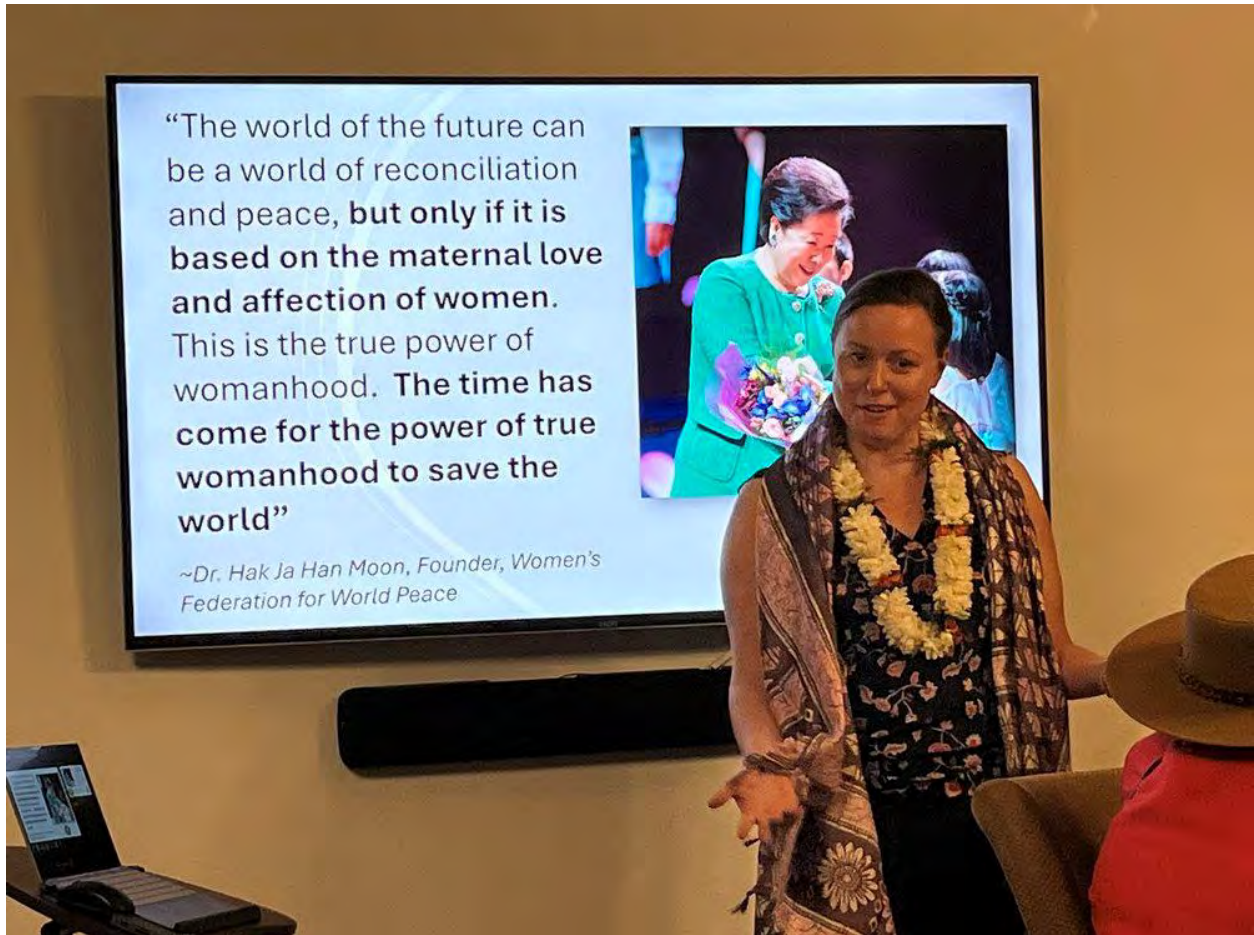
### Testimonies from the Evening
