



All Hands on Deck" Initiative

In the meeting, Pastor Daryl opened with a prayer, seeking guidance and inspiration from the Holy Mother and the spirit world. Belvedere then discussed the "All Hands on Deck" initiative, a national campaign where the Belvedere community has taken ownership to participate proactively. The purpose of this initiative is to unite in faith, align with Heaven's will, and take responsibility for their lives, their relationship with true parents, and their experience with the movement. Belvedere emphasized the importance of participation, taking responsibility, ownership, and experiencing grace. The conversation ended with a prayer and an invitation for questions.

Next Steps

- 1. Pastor Daryl to lead the new members goal of recruiting 10 new members
- 2. Pastor Mika and Christina Miyake to lead the blessing goal, including getting 7 more people to sign up for the Hyo Jung Blessing guide, 5 people registered for the blessing, and 5 people to RSVP for going to Korea.
- 3. Pastor Justin to lead the Cheonwon Gung donation goal, aiming to increase the number of donors from 39 to 55.
- 4. Pastoral team to organize and facilitate the All Hands on Deck day on Thursday, including setting up prayer sessions, brainstorming activities, and action periods for each goal.
- 5. Mika to create an RSVP form for the All Hands on Deck day and send it out via email. 6. All members to sign and share the petition for religious freedom in Japan by the next day.
- 7. Pastoral team to set up Zoom options for certain portions of the All Hands on Deck day, particularly the 1-2 PM and 8:30-9 PM sessions.
