Not Just Utopian Ideas

"Your new commitment must include practical action hand-inhand with your ideals, theories and dreams... [not just] utopian ideas, your theories must be proven to be true and valid in action and practice."

Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon, 1984 Commencement Address

As UTS' founder told graduating students in 1984, our commitment must be to live not just "utopian theories" but to test our beliefs in practical living and to assess them for their validity and practicality. He also said, "we must develop a 'practical application' movement."

This is our commitment at Barrytown College of UTS, to examine key aspects of Unificationist ideals and to see how they can be applied *in reality, both in our personal lives and in the public square.*

Fortunately cutting-edge science has been catching up to many of the assertions that the Principle makes. Just a few months ago, the University of Denver released <u>a major study</u> of the relationship between marital quality and relationship behaviors



before marriage. As the Principle teaches, those couples who had uncommitted intimate relationships before marriage had less happy marriages. Those who waited had happier marriages. The study also found that couples who had larger weddings had more successful marriages. (Unfortunately it did not determine if having *thousands of other couples* getting married at the same wedding was beneficial. :-)

In this context consider the sad, tragic social culture that exists on many campuses, especially in the area of male/female relationships. Most young men and women go to college hoping to make good friends and find someone special to love. Instead many <u>tragic situations</u> happen that scar these men and women for their entire lives. Colleges try, with little success, to intervene in such situations, without much reflection on the underlying premise about the purpose of relationships.

What will be our Founders' legacy in America? What will be our legacy as Unificationists? What will be the Barrytown legacy? I believe that, if we do our job correctly, other schools of higher education will send representatives to study what WE are doing at our institution. Several students and staff reflect on this question of legacy in the following video.
