Hyung Jin Nim began Sunday's Sermon by discussing how the worship of idols leads to worship of self and moral breakdown. He showed a fascinating video from the Bible Project, an animated explanation about why the Messiah is needed.

In the Genesis account of the Fall, in the garden, the "snake" tempted Eve by saying "you will be like God," leading her to reject God's word and to worship her own desire. "Yahweh Saves." You can't separate the Biblical providence from Jesus, or Father. We cannot return to God ourselves. Our love for Christ must be greater than the neo-pagan hatred of him that is rampant in our culture.



A few weeks ago, Rev. Yoo, the main lecturer of the OSDP content received the Sanctuary Blessing and repented for his rebellion against Father by opposing Kook Jin Nim and Hyung Jin Nim. Soon after Mother gathered main leaders and lecturers for a 2 day workshop. Many objected to the lecture given on the Only Begotten Daughter theology and to the explanation about the sale of precious holy land in Kuri where Father spoke so many times. Latest FFWPU Theological Heresies
