He discussed the Book of Ezra chapter 5's account of rebuilding the Temple with support from Cyrus, King of Persia. But after completing the Temple, they were disheartened to find that the power of God was not there. As recounted in Ezra 10, after reflection they realized that many Jewish men had married Babylonian women.

A similar example is Samson's pursuit of Philistine women, which led to his humiliation and downfall.

Intermarriage with women who practice different religions dilutes the faith of the husbands and the next generations. Their tears of joy become tears for justice to purify their national sin. Ezra issued a national divorce edict that all of the men who had returned to Jerusalem must remove their Babylonian wives and children.

Hyung Jin Nim explained that this shows how serious it is to leave True Father's Authority. Ezra 10:18 lists those guilty of intermarriage who repented and divorced their wives. It's important to remember who we are in God's providence.



He also spoke about a recent youtube video from The Bible Project about "The Satan and Demons" which shows Adam and Eve wearing crowns. The video's creators must have been guided spiritually to portray the first ancestors in this way. Those under True Father's authority can understand that this refers to the perfected Adam and Eve, True Father Sun Myung Moon and True Mother Hyun Shil Kang.

Then he invited all of those at the service to go with him to the True Parents' Memorial and Wonjeon for True Mother Kang being constructed near the Kahr Arms property in Greeley, PA.

Dear brothers and sisters,




I am John Raucci, and I have been with the Unification Sanctuary since 2015, and the Unification Church since 1974. I have come to know your activity from friendships that I have with a number of your adherents. I feel obligated to write this note, which in essence will be a reminder of something that Jesus taught us. That is, we should worship both in spirit and in truth.

I realize that you focus on one of Father's final speeches. And, by conveying that speech to others, you have moved many people. Father's words are very powerful. But, that speech, however significant, can by no means nullify the rest of what

Father said or did.

All of his words and deeds are significant. Father may try to simplify things for us by bringing attention to this final speech, but his life is so much more than anything I've seen or heard. In light of that, Father has chosen a successor.

That successor also elevates Father's words, but does something more, from what I can tell. He conveys Father's spirit, and in so doing, brings a life to Father's words which serves to express their fundamental meaning and essence.



It's like with the Bible. We are left with Jesus' words, but often without the spirit by which he conveyed those words. Those of us who have been privileged to spend time with Father understand a little of his spirit, and can understand the words along with that sense of spirit that was acquired through experience with Father.

Jesus may have come as a shepherd, but when we think about the Second Coming,

Christ comes a warrior. Just read the Book of Revelations to see if that's not true. Hyung Jin Nim is a warrior. It's not to say he's not loving and compassionate, but ultimately he stands strong against evil, and will fight it wherever it appears.

That's why he's so interested, especially in training young people, to be not only good husbands and wives, but to be defenders of the faith, and of the freedoms that come from God. Hyung Jin Nim is responsible for constructing the framework of the Kingdom, so he emphasizes new things, and people thus get confused about how closely he resembles Father. But, there's nothing in what Hyung Jin Nim says or does that is adverse to Father's words and deeds.

His spirit is remarkable, and his daily life as well. He can help us to really understand Father not only in truth, but in spirit as well. When Father selected Hyung Jin Nim as his successor, Father said he surpassed each of us in his faith, and in every other way. He called Hyung Jin Nim his "representative body." So, from Father's point of view, Hyung Jin Nim was the best one to convey Father's truth and Father's spirit. If we judge him while focusing on Father's words given in one final speech, we may not be looking at him the way Father was.
