She served as WFWPI UN Office Vienna Representative







during the CSW67 & CSW68 held in New York, USA for two consecutive years in 2023 and 2024. She is a WFWP Liaison Officer between Austria and the Philippines and the founder of "Moonlight Solar Lamp Project" with the 10K Heroes United Bohol as co-creators of the pilot project. Despite her hearing impairment, she was appointed as WFWP Carinthia Leader in August 2023; She joined her team in participating at UNODC Constructive Dialogue about Human trafficking and the Smuggling of Migrants, where she contributed and read a statement. Shortly afterwards, she initiated the online platform "Meet & Greet" for her passion in finding ways for a more resilient and sustainable solutions and to discover that magic formula how we could work in the future harmoniously together in pursuits of a better world for all.
