The character education seminar held in Pespire on April 25 was sponsored by an Ambassador for Peace.

Its main presentations on "The Importance of Living with Vision," taught about the potentially time-consuming influence of our simplest habits and how this can impact our life choices.

Speakers explained the distinction between virtues and addictions and showed examples of people who live a life full of vision and how this has a positive impact on society.
