

Weekend-Seminar in Camberg-Neumuehle

Bad Camberg, Germany, 28. – 30. November 2014



Finally, in this third weekend workshop after the renovation of our seminar house Neumuehle, we could make use of the big hall with our 21 participants, among them 5 guests. This time, with one third of the crowd being under 30 years old, two MC's - 1st Gen Heidi Wakayama and 2nd Gen Anja Wenzel – guided through the program, creating a good mix of experience and creative young spirit.



Friday evening, after the participants had introduced themselves, German national leader Dieter Schmidt explained about the Divine Principle as value-giving lighthouse in today's world. Also he emphasized the crucial role of the (blessed) family as foundation for a stable society.

Next morning spirit and body were refreshed with half an hour of Qi Gong exercises as well as a rich breakfast.

Then Claus Dubisz spoke on "Why we can meet God everywhere and He also us". An introductory video

visualized the greatness of God's creation, which can be found everywhere if only we have eyes to see.



In the next lectures Dieter Schmidt clarified the present situation of the family. The Fall of Man, and the resulting confusion about the true meaning of love, is revealed through disturbed relations between the sexes, and through the alienation between parents and children. Examples can be found in abundance in the yellow press. Here The Principle gives clear answers, and offers solutions.



After lunch we visited the centuries-old chapel in the nearby monastery Gnadenthal. Inspired workshop participants sang several Holy Songs in this old, but now well modernized house of God. The walk back to the Neumuehle was filled with deep discussions and exchange of ideas.



After coffee and cake the next lectures opened new insights into well-known Bible stories. It became clear how God had always tried to show the people a way out of their misery.

The culture evening was a professionally presented program with Italian pop songs from the 90ties, piano rap, an aesthetic short film by one of our guests,

other song and speech presentations, as well as instrumental pieces.

In the early Sunday morning meeting the lecturers and MC's decided some slight changes in the lectures, in order to adapt the presentation contents better to the needs of the guests. The explanation of the mission and life of Jesus, was followed by an overview of the parallel structures in providential history. Thus it became obvious that today we live at a turning point in God's providence. And also it became obvious, that at least a 7-day seminar is needed to be able to understand all these historical events correctly.

In his final lecture Dieter Schmidt shed light on the life of the founder, the late Rev. Sun Myung Moon. He invited all participants to partake in God's greatest gift of our time: the Holy Marriage Blessing. In all details he explained the meaning of the different ceremonies.

Now it is up to each participant to decide his or her next step.
