Concerning the current situation with COVID-19, at this time we are planning to run Camp Lone Star 2020 as per usual on the beautiful Morgan ranch. However, the safety and well-being of our camp family is our highest priority, and our core team is working hard to prepare for various contingencies. We are continuing to follow the recommended guidelines by the CDC, and if we are unable to meet in person at the end of June, we will instead have a virtual Camp Lone Star experience, which we will provide more details on if this is the best choice. We will update you as we know more and are able to make a clear decision on how to proceed for Camp Lone Star 2020.

If conditions allow us to safely have our camp in person, we will work to establish safe procedures including the following guidelines:

Participants, staff, and all guests must be fever-free for two weeks prior to arriving at camp.

Participants, staff, and all guests must feel well on opening day.

Participants, staff, and all guests must live in a home environment that has been free of COVID-19 for over two weeks and be medically cleared to attend.

We will add screening criteria based on the latest information and best practices at a future date.
