United with “Holy Mother Han” to Receive God’s Blessings



In her message, True Mother expressed that "During the 6,000 years of human history after the Fall, there was not a single day of true peace, due to wars and conflicts," sharing her heart with sorrow. She then emphasized that "The dream of the Creator, God, and humanity's yearning is to live the life of the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth. To create an environment where all people in the world can receive Heavenly Parent, the Pure Water of the first, second, and third generations must take responsibility. Only through this path can the great human family that embraces God and the world of peace be realized."

True Mother concluded her message pronouncing that 'Closing Prayer,' should conclude with: "In attending Holy Mother Han, I pray with gratitude in my name [___], of a blessed family. Aju."

The Worship Service celebrated True Parents' Birthday and the 12th Anniversary of Cheon Il Guk Foundation Day, expressing hopes for a Heavenly Unified Korea and world peace. The event was attended by key leaders including Sunhak Educational Foundation President Moon Yeon-ah, Korean Hyojeong Cultural Foundation President Julia H. Moon, Vice Chair of Cheon Mu Won, Wonju Jeong McDevitt, World Mission Headquarters Director General Song Yong-cheon, and FFWPU-Korea President Hwang Bo-guk, along with members from across the country.

Director Song Yong-cheon led the service, which proceeded with the singing of the Cheon Il Guk

President Kim Dong-woo. The program continued with Director Song's special report, songs of praise by the "Cheonmyeong" group, flower offerings by regional presidents, and the bestowal of holy items. Following True Mother's message, the service included an appointment ceremony for UPA's 10th graduating class as special envoys, a departure ceremony for the 2nd class of Heavenly Top Gun missionaries, and a Korean youth resolution ceremony. The event concluded with a presentation of "The Song of Han" by the Hyojeong Cultural Art Group and three cheers of Eok Mansei led by Hori Masaichi, Continental President of Heavenly Asia- Pacific.

In his special report, Director Song discussed preparations for the April Cheon Won Gung entry ceremony. He emphasized that blessed families should unite with True Parents and participate in the ceremony as chosen people and citizens of Cheon Il Guk, receiving God as true children and fulfilling their responsibilities.

Twenty-nine cadets graduated from the UPA 10th Class after completing their three-year training and were appointed as special youth ambassadors. At the Heavenly Top Gun missionaries' departure ceremony that followed, four representatives presented their resolution before True Mother, who bestowed holy salt from Death Valley and special badges upon them. The 116 young missionaries from UPA, Korea, and Japan will serve in 21 countries across six continents.



During the Korean Youth Resolution Ceremony, 1,000 young people performed "It Will Begin with Me" and "The Song of Warriors," pledging before God and True Parents to fulfill their mission as the future generation of Cheon Il Guk.



Cheon Il Guk Songs of Praise Festival

Immediately following the Worship Service, the "Cheon Il Guk Songs of Praise Festival" was held in competition format. Nine teams representing Korea, United States, Japan, Europe, South America, Asia, and Africa presented enthusiastic praise performances.

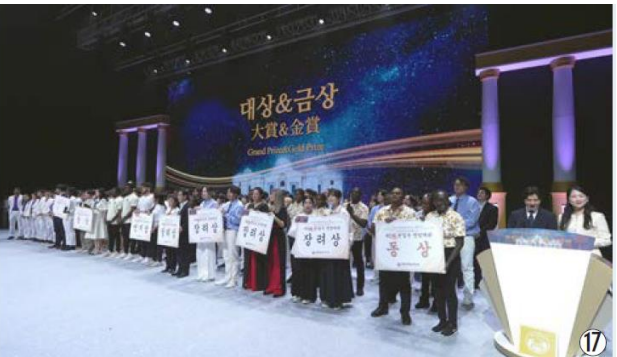


The "Luz Alma Vida" team from South America received the Grand Prize, while Benin's "Sunhak" choir won the Gold Medal, North America's "Peace Starts with Me" team won the Silver Medal, and the Solomon Islands Pacific "One Heart" and Korea's "Future Generation" teams received Bronze Medals. Merit and popularity awards were also presented.



Additionally, Happy Band and Honey Moon performed, and in the final performance, Moon Shin-chul and Moon Shin-heung, along with all participating teams and the Cheonmyeong group, sang "Monarch Butterfly."
