

National Education for Heavenly Unified Korea Forms Consensus for Unification

National education for Heavenly Unified Korea is being successfully conducted nationwide under the theme "God Bless Korea, Long Live the Republic of Korea," inspiring national consensus for peace and unification.



On January 21, Hwang Bo-kuk, President of Heavenly Korea, participated in the "Guri City National Education" at the Guri Veterans and Military Association Hall with about 200 citizens and key leaders including the Guri City Mayor, Chairman of the Guri City Council, and National Assembly Members' aides. He emphasized the excellence of Korean culture, the strong spiritual strength that has overcome crises, and the role of the chosen people. He then introduced the vision of the Cheon Won Gung entrance ceremony scheduled for April, along with the ideology of "One Family of Humanity Under Heaven."



Additionally, a "National Education Seongsan Rally" was held on January 19 in the form of a Christian-Unification Church joint worship service. Lee Hyun-young, President of the Korean Religious Association, who appeared as a guest speaker that day, reminded through his lecture that "the path for all religions in this world is one path, and the essence of religion is to attend God and expand goodness."

National education for Heavenly Unified Korea is scheduled to be conducted nationwide through lectures under the theme "God Bless Korea, Long Live the Republic of Korea," containing the content of the Epic History of the Chosen Korean People, until the end of March.

Meanwhile, on February 22 and 23, national education events hosted by National President Hwang Bok-kuk of Heavenly Korea were successfully held in Suwon and Cheongju.
