

Hyojeong Academic Foundation Signs MOU with Kenya Education Department

On July 3, a delegation from the Kakamega County Education Department in Kenya visited the HJ Cheonwon Complex in Korea. Their purpose was to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the distribution of Hyojeong character education materials and related activities.

The Kakamega County Education Department, which oversees education policies in southwestern Kenya, planned this visit to learn about distributing and teaching True Parents' Hyojeong character education materials.

Jin Sung-bae, Chairman of the Hyojeong Academic Foundation, emphasized the importance of True Parents' Hyojeong character education.
