Ceremony of Paying Respects at Bon Hyang Won

The ceremony, hosted by Kim In-chang, Director of Policy for Heavenly Korea, was attended by about 100 people including the True Family and key providential organization leaders. The morning unfolded with a series of meaningful rituals: the lighting of holy candles, floral tributes, silent and heartfelt prayers.

After the lighting of holy candles by the True Family, followed by representative flower offerings from the True Family and Cheon II Guk leaders, Hwang Bo-guk, President of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) in Korea, delivered a moving prayer:
