Afterward, a new of the Cheon II Guk Song of Praise Competition was created for the first time in history through the fierce competition of nine teams with formidable skills. As a result, the grand prize was awarded to the "Heavenly North America Peace Starts With Me Choir," which heated up the venue by well incorporating addictive melodies and unique music.



The gold prize went to Heavenly Asia Pacific's Voices of Hyojeong (Wang Appa, Wang Emma We Thank You), the silver prize to Heavenly Korea YSP (Following True Parents), and the bronze prize to the Cheonmyeong Choir (UPA, Monarch Butterfly). Encouragement prizes were awarded to Heavenly Latin America's New Hope Garden (Your Garden), Heavenly Japan's Kosei Choir, Heavenly Europe's The New Harmony Choir (In Gratitude for our True Parents' Love), Heavenly Korea's True Love Choir (From Halla to Baekdu, From Baekdu to the Ends of the Cosmos), and Heavenly Korea's Cheongra Choir (The Lord Has Come and Hallelujah).

True Mother also awarded a special prize to Heavenly Africa (Cheon II Guk), who couldn't participate directly and joined through video, concluding the entire event with great blessings.

The praise competition was structured around four key themes: Resolution and determination for the victorious entry into the Cheon Il Sanctum in Cheon Won Gung, Celebration of the life achievements of the True Parents, Discovery and nurturing of new praise songs and teams for the Cheon Il Guk era, Revitalization of Cheon Il Guk praise culture and strengthening of cultural mission capabilities.

The event showcased two categories of musical entries: original praise songs and songs without copyright issues. All submissions were required to have been created after the proclamation of the Cheon II Guk Foundation Day in 2013.

The event was themed "Songs of Victory and Resolution, Cheon II Guk's Harmony Becoming One with True Parents," featured nine teams selected from continents worldwide.
