HPHC Yeosu City's Our Destiny is Harmony and Unification Peace March

The Universal Peace Federation (UPF) hosted the 'Yeosu City Harmony and Unification Peace March' under the theme 'North-South Unification is Our Destiny' on September 8, 2024, at the D'Ocean Hotel in Yeosu. The event drew 500 attendees, including 350 leaders from various sectors of Yeosu City.

The event, moderated by Professor Lim Chae-ran of Kyonggi University, featured a series of activities: singing of national anthem, congratulatory performances, and the presentation of merit plaques. Jung Jae-hoon, UPF Yeosu Branch Director, introduced VIPs, followed by welcoming remarks from Lee Jongseok, President of Yeosu City Ambassadors for Peace Council. Dr. Kim Kyung-hee delivered a cultural lecture, and Lee Woo-beom, President of Chonnam National University, offered congratulatory remarks.



Yang Chang-shik, UPF World Chairman, gave a peace lecture, after which new Peace Ambassadors were appointed. The program concluded with a photo session and a Peace Road launching ceremony led by Jung Woo-chul, Chairman of the National Committee for Unification Preparation.

In his peace lecture, Yang Chang-shik, UPF World Chairman, emphasized, the potential for North-South unification through a global peace movement based on the philosophy of Rev. Sun Myung Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon. encouraged participants to spark a "wind of peace" in Yeosu City, to prepare for Heavenly Unified Korea, which will grow globally, just as Korea has progressed from a developing country to join the ranks of advanced nations."

The event saw 260 new Peace Ambassadors appointed, with 10 representatives receiving certificates on stage. All participants then joined in a launching ceremony, carrying banners and flags expressing their

wishes for North-South unification.

The event concluded with all attendees singing "Our Cherished Hopes are for Unity," a song embodying their fervent desire for unification.

UPF, marking its 19th anniversary on September 12, is a global NGO with 'general consultative status' at the UN Economic and Social Council. In Korea, it maintains a presence in 15 metropolitan areas and 232 local districts, embodying its commitment to grassroots peace initiatives.
