## Chuseok bows of respect at the Paju Won Jeon in the 12th Year of Cheon II Guk

The Chuseok ceremony for paying respects at the Paju Won Jeon for the Liberation of Heaven and Earth was held on August 15th by the Heavenly Calendar (September 17th) in the 12th Year of Cheon II Guk.
