Los Angeles, Southern California: 'Removing the Line: North-South Korea Unity Symposium'

On the same day, October 5, CARP Los Angeles held a 'Mobile North-South Unification Symposium' targeting Korean-American expatriates in Koreatown. The event was attended by over 130 supporters, including Pastors Joshua and Takayo Holmes, Rev. Chang Woon Jeong, and Dr. Teddy Choi, a North

Korean defector. This symposium aimed to convey love for the Republic of Korea and Heavenly Unified Korea based on True Parents' words, raise awareness of the historical reality of unification, and promote peaceful unification through the participation of Korean-American expatriates, amidst the current tense situation in inter-Korean relations.



The event included cultural performances, viewing of True Parents' visit to North Korea, special lectures on the importance of North-South unification, testimonies from North Korean defectors, and comprehensive discussions and Q and A sessions. Participants emphasized the message that "70 years of division is enough," stating that it's tragic to use resources for war preparations when they are insufficient to respond to global challenges like climate change.

CARP Los Angeles pledged to continue holding unification symposiums based on positive public opinion and to continue activities for Korean Peninsula unification through the interest of dignitaries and young Americans.
