Peace Education and Missionary Activities of Central African Youth

On October 27, Central African youth (Cheon Il Guk-CA) successfully conducted special education for peace and harmony in Lemba, Democratic Republic of Congo. Organized in cooperation with Mayor Ernest Makiese Ndudi, the event drew 200 participants, including 87 couples.

The education focused on understanding Heavenly Parent's will and True Parents' status and value, aiming to achieve peace and harmony within the village community. Mayor Ndudi emphasized the importance of education, stating it "will brighten the village's future by realizing Heavenly Parent's will."

The program centered on True Mother's words, followed by education for couples and the Holy Wine Ceremony for those receiving the Blessing. During this time, participants renewed their hope for the future of families and village communities. One participant shared, "The wisdom learned has positively impacted our family," pledging to "become messengers spreading this wisdom with her husband and conveying True Mother's teachings." Cheon Il Guk-CA plans to conduct additional education for couples and children's seminars in three weeks, providing opportunities for families to grow together and strengthen village development and peace.



Youth Workshop

On November 1-2, Cheon Il Guk-CA held a two-day workshop at CEBCO Church in Nsonsa Mpangu village, Democratic Republic of Congo, attracting 250 youth. The workshop focused on True Parents' status and absoluteness, providing great spiritual inspiration to participants. Upon completion, certificates were awarded to all attending youth.



Heavenly Tribal Messiah: Preparation Workshop in Kikwit

From October 27 to November 3, a seven-day workshop was held in Kikwit, Democratic Republic of Congo. This workshop part of the education program for Heavenly Tribal Messiah blessings, attracted 57 participants.



Of these, 47 were young people from the Paulin Pelekay CheonBo tribe, with 10 others from neighboring tribes. Participants aged 17-24 studied True Parents' life course and the meaning of the Blessing.

Heavenly Africa aims to prepare 1,800 single candidates through similar programs throughout the continent. Additionally, the Heavenly Tribal Messiah program is being prepared with a target of 302 candidates. Following the workshop, many young people expressed deep gratitude to True Mother and committed themselves to preparing for the 2025 Blessing Ceremony.
