Our mission at Up & Coming is to help Young Unificationist's feel God's love through weekly fellowship and guidance in order to strengthen their lives of faith. We hold this mission very close to our hearts and would like to continue to create an environment where this can be possible. Below you will find the Dress Code and Code of Conduct that makes our program great! Your cooperation in supporting these rules is greatly appreciated, and will help to ensure that we are pursuing the fulfillment of the objectives of Up & Coming:

Dress Code: We want all participants to wear clothes that aren't revealing and are conducive to promoting a healthy atmosphere of brother and sister relationships.

- No tank tops, midriffs, spaghetti straps (no bra straps showing)
- No short-shorts or short hemlines
- No inappropriate t-shirts or logos on clothing
- No exposed underwear
- No tight clothes

Code of Conduct:

- Avoid restricted areas on the Belvedere Property
- Respect the speaker (ie. no falling asleep/laying down, no side conversations, no phone usage)
- Clean up after yourself
- Follow Brother/Sister Rules (please reference rules in the following page)
- No use of inappropriate language
- No weapons
- No use of illegal substances (ie. vape pens, alcohol, nicotine products, etc)
- No violence, harassment or bullying
